NGO led Initiatives in Gandhinagar during Covid-19 Situation

Earthkids Humanity Foundation is working in Gandhinagar city during the COVID-19 pandemic situation and helping the migrant workers and needy people in the city. The foundation responded to the COVID-19 pandemic by creating awareness about social distancing, handwashing and COVID-19 to more than 3000 labours in the city and distributed the masks to around 2000 labour. The foundation also has carried out fogging activities in labour colonies to sanitize their areas. The foundation have explained the labour the importance of the lockdown and insisted the labours to not travel to their respective hometown risking their own and their family's life.















Earthkids Humanity Foundation has also worked with Gandhinagar Municipal Corporation before the COVID-19 pandemic situation. To make Gandhinagar city litter free, the foundation launched a project called "PcanV". This project involves Paanwalas, Chaywalas, Autowalas, Nature-lovers, and Volunteers, who are given the title of "Green Warriors" for keeping their surrounding glitter free. About 20 Paanwalas, Chaywalas and Autowalas were given litterbins with a logo and message from the foundation and a label of Green Warrior to place near there shop or in the auto rickshaw. These people started using the provided litterbins for throwing garbage and also stopped their customers from littering around. In addition to this, more than 700 Nature Lovers and Volunteers were involved in cleaning the city through 17 plogging events organised by the foundation. Around 4.1 tons of plastic litter is picked-up by the Green Warriors during the plogging events organised every Sunday morning at different places in Gandhinagar city.
