

The 44th meeting of Central Sanctioning & Monitoring Committee (CSMC) meeting was held on 28th June 2019 which was chaired by Secretary, Ministry of Housing & Urban Affairs. CSMC considered and

accepted a total of 747 projects from 10 States under PMAY(U). It involved projects for construction of 2,51,093 houses with a total investment of Rs11,373.20 crores which includes central

assistance of Rs 3766.40 crores. The States that participated in the meeting were Assam. Bihar. Chhattisgarh, Gujarat, Jharkhand, Maharashtra, Meghalaya, Nagaland, Tamilnadu & Uttar Pradesh.



Secretary, MoHUA congratulated the Government of Uttar Pradesh for securing the top position amongst all States with 13 lakh houses sanctioned under PMAY(U).
