- (v) The subsequent amounts of interest subsidy will be released to NHB after 70% utilization of earlier released amounts, on quarterly basis, and based on claims raised by NHB in the prescribed format (Annexure 3 of the scheme guidelines).
- (vi) PLIs will be given a lump sum amount of Rs. 2,000/- per sanctioned application in lieu of processing fee for housing loan for the borrower under the scheme.
- (vii) 0.1 % of total fund disbursement to the PLIs will be paid to NHB for their administrative expenses for which NHB will furnish the details to M/o HUA.
- (viii) NHB will submit progress reports including the details of expenditure to M/o HUA regularly in the prescribed formats.
- (ix) Where there is an element of cash transfer the same may be made through PFMS/DBT mode as applicable.

Subject: Request from NHB to release advance subsidy of Rs.1,301 crore for utilization under CLSS for MIG component of PMAY (U).

PUC (pp.204-206/c) may kindly be seen.

Credit Linked Subsidy Scheme for MIG (CLSS-II for MIG) is one of the four verticals under PMAY and is being implemented as a Central Sector Scheme for eligible Middle Income Groups (MIG) residing in urban areas in which interest subsidy is provided on home loans availed through Primary Lending Institutions (PLIs).

2. For implementation of CLSS component of PMAY (U) mission, Ministry had initially, identified two Central Nodal Agencies (CNAs) i.e. National Housing Bank (NHB) and Housing and Urban Development Corporation Ltd. (HUDCO) to channelize the subsidy to the Primary Lending Institutions (PLIs). These two CNAs have signed Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the PLIs for implementation of the scheme. Ministry has further included State Bank of India (SBI) as its third CNA for CLSS w.e.f. 06.08.2019. SBI Corporate Centre, Mumbai will act as a CNA for SBI Bank branches only.

3. NHB has submitted Utilization Certificate (pp.205/c) in the prescribed format (Annexure 3 of revised scheme guidelines of CLSS for MIG) and requested for further release of Rs. 1,301 crore for implementation of CLSS for MIG.

4. NHB has so far been released a total of Rs.6,179 crore under CLSS for '1IG component of PMAY(U) mission. Year wise details of funds released may be seen here (pp.207/c).

5. From the UC, it is seen that interest earned on the funds as on 31.03.2020 is Rs.54.74 crore and refund received from the PLIs, pending settlement is Rs.13.06 crore. As per UC, NHB has released Rs.6,237.51 crore as interest subsidy under CLSS for MIG scheme to the PLIs for their claims under the scheme and the amount is more than 70% of the total of advance subsidy released to NHB and the interest accrued (i.e. Rs.6,179 crore + Rs.54.74 crore), that is a necessary condition for subsequent release to CNAs under para 5.1 of scheme guidelines of CLSS for MIG (pp.116/c).

6. In the BE- 2020-21, funds of Rs.500 crore had been allocated under Budget Head 2216.02.190.18.08.33 which provides for subsidy under Credit Linked Subsidy Scheme-II (CLSS-II) for MIG component of PMAY (U) Mission in the Demand No. 57 of the MoHUA for the year 2020-21 out of which Rs.199 crore has been released to NHB for utilization under CLSS-MIG. Another proposal for release of Rs.50 crore to SBI is under process in e-file 9080504 after disbursement of which an amount of Rs.251 crore will be available in the aforementioned budget head. Therefore, as per availability, amount of Rs.251 crore may be released to NHB at the current instance.

7. If approved, the file may be sent to the IFD for its concurrence to release **Rs.251 crore (Rupees Two Hundred Fifty One Crore only)** to NHB as advance subsidy to be utilized under CLSS for MIG component of PMAY (U) as per DFA/9108423.

From the allocated funds under BE 2020-21 for CLSS for MIG, an amount of Rs.199 crore has been released to NHB.

NHB has further requested for Rs.1301 crore for meeting cases under MIG. At present NHB has about 50,000 claims in MIG category to clear for which an amount of Rs.770 crore (approx.) is needed. Also, SBI has about 12,000 cases for processing under MIG category which required an amount of Rs185 crore (approx.). NHB and SBI both have been requesting for more funds. However, considering that NHB has more pending cases vis-a-vis SBI, if approved an amount of Rs.251 crore may be released to NHB. This will left only Rs.50 crore available for release and it may be released to SBI (instead of earlier proposed Rs.100 crore to SBI in efile 9080504 which has been concurred by IFD).

The proposal relates to the release of Rs. 251.00 crore to NHB as advance for MIG component of CLSS under PMAY (U).

2. In the BE 2020-21, funds of Rs. 500 crore has been allocated under CLSS-II for MIG component of PMAY (U). IFD vide its <u>Notes # 256 to 257</u> has already concurred to release Rs. 400 crore to NHB for this Scheme.

3. PD has stated that Rs. 199 crore were released during the month of May, 2020 as funds amounting to Rs. 200 crore or more can be released during the window period between 21st to 25th dates of a month. As such an amount of Rs. 201 crore is still left with PD (out of the existing concurred amount of Rs. 400 crore, as stated in para 2).

4. Further, PD stated that NHB requires Rs. 770 crore (approx.) to clear about 50,000 claims in MIG category. A nother, nodal agency, SBI has about 12,000 cases for processing under MIG category which required an amount of Rs 185 crore (approx.).

5. PD has now requested to release an amount of Rs. 251 crore to NHB. This will leave only Rs.50 crore available for release which may be released to SBI (instead of earlier proposed Rs.100 crore to SBI in efile 9080504 which has been concurred by IFD). The release of Rs. 50 crore to SBI is being processed in the concerned file separately.

6. In view of the above, IFD may concur the proposal of releasing Rs. 251 crore to NHB for CLSS-MIG Scheme subject to the compliance of Scheme Guidelines and approval of Competent Authority. PD is also requested to firm up such release cases after discussing with the concerned CNAs so that proposals are processed smoothly.
