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Minutes of the 34th meeting of the Central Sanctioning and Monitoring Committee (CSMC) under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (Urban) - Housing for All Mission held on 30 May 2018

The 34th meeting of the Central Sanctioning and Monitoring Committee (CSMC) under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (Urban) [PMAY(U)] was held on 30 May 2018 at 2.00 p.m. in the Conference Room, Nirman Bhawan, New Delhi, with Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs in Chair. The list of participants is at **Annexure-I**.

- 2. At the outset, the Secretary, Ministry of Housing & Urban Affairs (MoHUA) welcomed the participants/representatives from the State Governments, participants/officers of the Ministry and other Departments. He reiterated that while considering the project proposals submitted by the States/UTs under PMAY(U), the CSMC reviews the progress of the States and gives directions for proper and rapid implementation/execution of the projects.
- 2.1. Accordingly, the following Decisions/Observations for compliance by all State/UT Governments were emphasised:
 - i. State Governments may prepare short films, printed literature/documents on projects undertaken under PMAY (U) to showcase how lives of beneficiaries have transformed. It should be widely circulated both in print and electronic media and also in various social media platforms for generating awareness.
 - ii. State/UT Governments may offer incentives through additional FAR for rehabilitation of slums in private land through ISSR. Increase of FAR upto 50% can be considered which will incentivise developers to undertake construction work on privately owned land for meeting the "Housing for All" goal.
 - iii. State/UT Governments may consider providing monetary incentive to the beneficiaries who complete construction work early under BLC (N) and BLC (E) components as is being done by the Government of Odisha. This will help in early completion of houses.
 - iv. 100% Aadhaar seeding of beneficiaries is a must for all projects under PMAY (U). All States/UTs are to ensure that beneficiary details entered in the PMAY (U) MIS are Aadhaar based and name of the beneficiary as in Aadhaar is entered to avoid any mismatch at a later stage.
 - v. States/UTs need to expedite grounding of approved projects so that they are completed within the timeline.
 - vi. State/UT Governments should exempt sanctioning of building plan on plot size less than 100 sq. metre. States/UTs may also prepare and circulate standard building plan designs for a plot size upto 100 sq. metre.
- States/UTs should ensure that the PMAY (U) logo is displayed in all housing units constructed under the Mission.
- viii. The State/UT Governments should consider ISSR component of PMAY (U) for rehabilitation of slums since it requires lesser investment as land is used as a resource which is readily available with the State/UT/ULBs.
- ix. State/UT Governments are advised to ensure that:
 - Adequate infrastructure is provided including individual water, sanitation and electricity connections.
 - There should be no duplication/change in the identified beneficiaries.
 - · Demarcation of land and mutation is carried out before implementation.
 - The design and construction of houses is disaster resilient and the specifications conform to IS/ NBC norms.

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- w. With regard to the vacant houses, if any, under JnNURM, the State Governments/UTs should look for realistic, pragmatic options so as to allot these houses to eligible beneficiaries in urban areas without any further delay.
- xi. States/UTs should implement innovative, cost effective and high quality construction technologies for constructing the housing units under PMAY (U). The tender documents should preferably be technology neutral and a clause of quality assurance for the potential bidders should be included.
- xii. State/UTs must expeditiously complete demand survey so that the target of the Mission Housing for All by 2022 is achieved in time. 100% of the total housing demand should be approved in the FY 2018-19 so that there is ample time for completion of projects within the Mission period.
- xiii. States/UTs may prefer arranging rent to the beneficiaries during the interim period of construction of houses under ISSR projects for its speedy completion.
- xiv. The States/UTs shall furnish regular update on the above issues to the HFA Mission Directorate, MoHUA.
- xv. The States/UTs should submit project proposals for consideration of CSMC by <u>15th of each month</u> so that site scrutiny/desk scrutiny in respect of identified DPRs can be done before the CSMC holds meeting.
- xvi While submitting project proposal for the city, the HFAPoA should have been submitted. If not ,suitable reason should be given.
- 3. Joint Secretary and Mission Director (HFA) introduced the agenda for the meeting. The agenda items also form part of the minutes. The item-wise minutes are recorded as follows:

- iv. All mandatory conditions required under PMAY (U) may be completed immediately.
- V. The NBC norms for construction of houses must be ensured keeping in view the disaster vulnerable region.
- Vi. There is no restriction to follow SECC data only, for identification of beneficiary under PMAY (U).

- VIII. Utilization Certificates of Rs. 66.89 crore is pending under PMAY (U). State to expedite submission of pending UCs.
- ix. Out of 69,187 houses sanctioned earlier, beneficiaries attached with valid Aadhaar are only 55,696. State to expedite all MIS entries and beneficiaries attachment.

The Committee was informed that HFAPoAs for the States of Kerala and Himachal Pradesh have been submitted to the Ministry after approval from respective State Level Sanctioning and Monitoring Committees (SLSMCs) as per PMAY (U) guidelines. The details are as under:

Kerala

Adhering to para 8.3 &8.8 of the PMAY (U) guidelines, the State government of Kerala has conducted demand survey and submitted a total of 63 HFAPoAs (out of 93 approved towns) to the Ministry after approval of SLSMC. A total of 63 HFAPoAs were placed before CSMC for record. The appraisal of the HFAPoAs has been carried out as per the approved Appraisal Format under the Mission. The assessment of the HFAPoAs have recorded a total demand in 63 town to be 99,074 under 4 verticals of the Mission with a total projected *Central assistance of Rs. 1748.44 Crore.* The *State share is Rs. 2282.24* Crore as Government of Kerala contributed Rs. 6.00 lakh per house under AHP and Rs. 0.50 lakh per house under BLC components of the Mission. The highest demand has been received under BLC component of the Mission. The break up of the total demand is as under:

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ISSR:0 (0:0%)

CLSS:22,422 (22.64%)

AHP:34,527 (34.84%)

BLC: 42,125(42.51%)

The State of Kerala has phased out entire housing demand between 2017-18 and 2020-21. The highest number of houses is proposed in the year 2018-19 (30,829) followed by 2017-18(26,247) across all verticals. As per the HFAPoA phasing plan till the year 2017-18, the State has planned for 35,783 houses for the 63 towns.

ii. Himachal Pradesh

Adhering to para 8.3 &8.8 of the PMAY (U) guidelines, the State government of Himachal Pradesh has conducted demand survey and submitted a total of 54 HFAPoAs to the Ministry after approval of SLSMC. A total of 54 HFAPoA were placed before CSMC for record. The appraisal of the HFAPoAs has been carried out as per the approved Appraisal Format under the Mission. The assessment of the HFAPoAs has recorded a total demand in 54 towns to be 15,863 under 4 verticals of the Mission with a total projected Central Assistance of Rs.242.01 Crore. The State share is Rs. 22.43 Crore. The highest demand has been received under BLC component of the Mission. The break-up of total demand is as under:

- iii. State Nodal agency is suggested to coordinate with all Collectors/Commissioners of all the districts to develop projects under different verticals. Also coordination with Nagar panchayat may be helpful for preparation of projects under PMAY (U).
- iv. The State needs to expedite the demand survey process and submit HFAPoAs for all the approved cities under the Mission at the earliest.
- The grounding of houses needs to be expedited so that the construction can be completed as per schedule timeline.
- vi. Out of 1,91,023 houses sanctioned earlier, beneficiaries attached with valid Aadhaar are 30,165 only. The State should expedite all MIS entries and beneficiary attachment immediately.
- vii. Utilization Certificates for Rs. 371.58 cr. is pending under PMAY (U). State should expedite submission of pending UCs immediately.
- viii. JNNURM: State Government should allot unoccupied houses immediately and excess ACA drawn may be refunded with interest to the Government of India.

During 34th CSMC meeting, a presentation on PMAY (U) MIS system was made focussing on data entry status and gaps on following parameters:-

- Project Annexure Upload.
- 2. Beneficiary Attachments with valid Aadhaar details.
- Online uploading of MPR (Monthly Progress Report) including Physical and Financial progress every month.
- 4. Geo-Tagging of Houses.
- Updation of Invalid and Duplicate Aadhaar with correct seeding of Aadhaar number on MIS.
- 6. Updation of SLTCs and CLTCs under Capacity Building Module.
- 7. Updation of HFAPoA and AIPs in MIS.



During the presentation, qualities of geo-tagged photos of completed houses under BLC component were also showcased. All States/UTs were also requested to moderate/approve photos as per the guidelines / specifications.

In the meeting, States/UTs were apprised that DBT (Direct Benefit Transfer) Mission under Cabinet Secretariate are seeking monthly report on funds released and number of transaction for both in-cash and in-kind component (AHP, ISSR, BLC). The information which would be provided by States/UTs in PMAY-MIS would be seamlessly transferred to DBT portal. Hence State/UTs need to validate the information properly before submitted in the newly developed DBT form in PMAY-MIS. The Ministry also requested to complete data entry for below mentioned periods on urgent basis latest by 15th June, 2018:-

- a. Since inception upto 31st March, 2018.
- b. DBT data for the month of April, May, 2018.

14 Other important observations/directions of CSMC

The following important observations were made regarding project proposals and implementation of projects under PMAY (U). States should take note of the observations of CSMC and take further action accordingly:

- All States were requested to provide details of ongoing residential housing projects by the government, private developers, builders, individual households etc.
- ii. First instalment of Central Assistance in case of BLC/ISSR projects shall be released when all beneficiaries in the project are Aadhaar seeded and in case of AHP projects 2nd instalment shall be released only after Aadhaar seeding of all beneficiaries is captured in the project. Hence, claim for release of 2nd instalment of Central Assistance for a project must be submitted only after the Aadhaar seeding of all the beneficiaries in the project is completed in PMAY (U)-MIS by the State/UT Governments.
- iii. The Secretary, MoHUA directed that MIS report(s) captured in PMAY (U) may be shared with States/UTs on fortnightly basis.
- iv. It was directed that all States/UTs should saturate their total demand for sanction in the year 2018-19 itself, which would enable them to complete all the houses by 2021-22 along with UCs and completion certificates etc.
- V. The Secretary (MoHUA) desired the States/UTs to collect data in respect of houses of EWS/LIG category which are being constructed through State sponsored schemes, Development Authorities, Housing Boards, Private Developers and Individual constructions in all statutory towns. EA/NBO will coordinate the efforts and will update regularly the progress made.
- vi. The States/UTs to share good quality images of the housing for documentation of case studies. It was also advised to document success stories of the PMAY (U) projects which highlight a tangible change in the lives of the beneficiaries due to this programme.
- vii. MoHUA will document, film and disseminate the good practices through its quarterly newsletters.
- Viii. The States were advised to incorporate latest technology in construction of housing units and document the same.
- ix. A robust MT. System is critical for PMAY (U) Mission. States need to constantly monitor the progress of survey data entries and link of beneficiaries to sanctioned

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projects in PMAY (U)-MIS. All States/UTs to ensure that the Aadhaar details of beneficiaries with regards to their number and name is accurate while updating in MIS. Beneficiary's details to be entered in the PMAY (U) MIS should be Aadhaar based and name of beneficiary as it is in Aadhaar should be entered.

V. Under PMFS/DBT process, the funds would have to be transferred at every stage only through electronic mode. This may relate to PMAY(U) as under:

(a) In case of Centrally sponsored schemes:

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For Beneficiary Led individual house Construction (BLC) and ISSR, under PMAY (U), the bank account details of the beneficiaries should necessarily be mapped so that the funds can flow to the beneficiaries' bank account directly. In the case of Affordable Housing in Partnership (AHP), the 2nd instalment to the State Government should be released only after receipt of beneficiary list with linkage of Aadhaar numbers of the beneficiaries duly certified by the State Government/ UT concerned and uploaded in the PMAY- MIS portal.

(b) In case of Central Sector Scheme:

for CLSS, the Central assistance is deposited upfront in the loan account of the beneficiary, after the bank receives the funds from CNAs.

 State/UTs to expedite finalisation of agencies for TPQM and Social Audit as per the guidelines.

Xii. State Level Appraisal Committee is expected to thoroughly appraise the DPRs before submitting the same to State Level Sanctioning & Monitoring Committee for approval. Combining SLAC and SLSMC meeting is not permissible as the mandate of the two bodies is distinct.

XIII. Projects such as VAMBAY, JNNURM, which have already been funded under housing schemes of GoI should not be considered for further funding under PMAY (U).

XIV. Under BLC, all individual houses shall have to be Geo-tagged on the BHUVAN(MoHUA) application. Further, the States are advised to release funds to the beneficiary only after the beneficiary completes the construction up to foundation level through their own funds.

XV. It has come to notice that some individual/organizations are collecting registration money etc. from potential beneficiaries seeking dwelling units in PMAY (U). The Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs has not authorized any individual/organization/agency to collect application/registration fee for applying for Houses in PMAY (U). Thus, no individual/agency/organization can collect any money/application fee from the beneficiary for enrolment under PMAY(U). All State Governments may also issue disclaimer to this effect in their relevant websites/advertisements etc. to stop this fraudulent activity.

xvi. BMTPC to come out with a standard layout for BLC projects for all States/UTs. (Action: BMTPC).

XVII. Since Rajiv Awas Yojana (RAY) is subsumed in Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana PMAY (U), Third Party Quality and Monitoring Agencies (TPQMA) appointed for PMAY (U) may also certify quality aspects of RAY projects.

XVIII. All States/UTs should utilize the released central funds expeditiously and submit Utilisation Certificates duly signed by competent authority in State/UT Governments as in the prescribed format given in the scheme guidelines. Parking of funds should be avoided.

XIX. The MoHUA has formulated PPP Models for Affordable Housing' to enable States/UTs to facilitate private sector participation, in order to meet the growing need of affordable housing in the country. The States/UTs are advised to make use of these guidelines suitably for PPP projects on affordable housing.

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XX. Allotment of houses in AHP and ISSR vertical of PMAY (U) should be Aadhaar enabled, provision for which has already been made in PMAY (U)-MIS.
