



Hon'ble Prime Minister addresses 'Garib Kalyan Sammelan' in Shimla, interacts with PMAY-U beneficiary

Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi addressed 'Garib Kalyan Sammelan' in Shimla, Himachal Pradesh on 31st May 2022. This event marked the completion of eight years of the Government and was organised across the country. As part of the Sammelan, elected public representatives directly interacted with the public to get feedback about the various welfare programmes being run by the Government. Hon'ble Governor of Himachal Pradesh Shri Rajendra Arlekar, Hon'ble Chief Minister of Himachal Pradesh Shri Jai Ram Thakur and Hon'ble Minister of Information & Broadcasting and Youth Affairs & Sports Shri Anurag Singh Thakur were among those present on the occasion in Shimla.

At the event, Hon'ble Prime Minister interacted with beneficiaries of various Government schemes, including Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (Urban). An interaction was held with PMAY-U beneficiary from Ladakh, Shri Tashi Tundup, to whom the Hon'ble Prime Minister asked about his experience with the Government schemes. Shri Tashi Tundup shared that he earlier lived in a kutchha house and faced lot of problems; however, after he got Central Assistance to build a pucca house under PMAY-U, he is leading a secured and dignified life. He has also got benefits of other Government Schemes in getting gas

connections and farming-related benefits.

"When the day-to-day struggle of the poor is reduced, he becomes empowered and he commits himself with new energy to get rid of his poverty. With this approach, our government is engaged in empowering the poor from day one. We have tried to ease every concern in his life. Today, 3 crore poor people of the country have got their pucca and new houses, where they have started living," Hon'ble Prime Minister said while addressing the gathering.

About the interaction with PMAY-U beneficiary Shri Tashi Tundup, Hon'ble Prime Minister said, "Right now, we were talking to a retired soldier from Ladakh. He had spent his life in the army, but he is getting a pucca house after the formation of our government."

During the Garib Kalyan Sammelan several activities were also hosted by States/UTs and team PMAY-U to make the event a grand success. Interactions were held with PMAY-U beneficiaries, allotment letters were also distributed as part of the programme. At all districts, officials, experts and beneficiaries gathered together to watch the programme live.

Hon'ble Prime Minister participates in 'Gujarat Gaurav Abhiyan' at Vadodara



On 18th June 2022, Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi participated in 'Gujarat Gaurav Abhiyan' in Vadodara, wherein he inaugurated and laid the foundation stone of development projects worth ₹ 21,000 crore. Hon'ble Chief Minister of Gujarat Shri Bhupendra Patel, other dignitaries and beneficiaries of different Government schemes were present on the occasion.

The event was held virtually from Vadodara across 15 cities and more than 25,000 beneficiaries attended the programme. Hon'ble Prime Minister said that the "government has given top priority to providing houses to eligible beneficiaries".

Under PMAY-U, a total number of 41,070 houses were inaugurated by Hon'ble Prime Minister, which includes Lokarpan of 38,071 houses worth ₹ 1,799 crore and Khatmuhurat of 3,000 houses worth ₹ 311 crore.



On the occasion, Hon'ble Chief Minister of Gujarat said that "under the leadership of Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi, Gujarat Government has sanctioned 8.61 lakh houses till date and completed construction of 6.50 lakh houses."

Hon'ble Union Minister lays foundation stone for Demonstration Housing Project at Dimapur, Nagaland



On the momentous occasion of completion of 7 years of PMAY-U, Hon'ble Union Minister for Housing & Urban Affairs Shri Hardeep Singh Puri virtually laid the foundation stone for Demonstration Housing Project (DHP) at Dimapur, Nagaland.

Hon'ble Ministers from Nagaland Shri Tongpang Ozukum and Shri V. Kashiho Sangtam, Hon'ble Deputy Speaker of Nagaland Assembly Shri T Yangseo Sangtam and officials of MoHUA were also present.

In Nagaland, 40 (G+2) houses will be constructed using 'Prefabricated Sandwich Panel System-EPS Cement Sandwich Panels with steel structure' technology. The building will be equipped with all basic and modern facilities, including a working women hostel, community centre, office, medical room, dining room with kitchen, activity room & guest room.

DHPs are model housing projects built with innovative construction technologies under Technology Sub-Mission component of PMAY-U. Under the project, resource-efficient, cost-effective, eco-friendly, disaster-resilient houses are built.

7th anniversary of Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana-Urban celebrated by MoHUA



Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA) organised a virtual event on 24th June 2022 to celebrate seven years of Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana-Urban (PMAY-U), which was launched by Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi on 25th June 2015. The event was presided by Shri Manoj Joshi, Secretary, MoHUA, and was attended by senior officials of the Ministry, Principal Secretaries of States/UTs, Mission Directors of States/UTs and stakeholders from Central and State Governments. The seventh anniversary celebrations highlighted the important initiatives implemented under PMAY-U Mission, which is one of the largest urban housing programmes in the world. At the outset, a movie capturing the glorious seven years journey of PMAY-U was showcased depicting how the Mission is fulfilling the dream of a pucca house for millions of Indians.

An e-Book encapsulating achievements of the Mission was released by Secretary, MoHUA. The book takes the readers through the initiatives and reforms that have been undertaken by the Mission to transform the urban landscape of India and more importantly, the impact it has had on the lakhs of beneficiaries of PMAY-U, who are proud owners of a pucca house with all basic amenities.

At the event, winners of 'Khushiyan Ka Aashiyana' Short Film Contest were also declared. The contest was launched by MoHUA as part of

Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav celebrations. It was open to PMAY-U beneficiaries, students, youths, civil society organisations, institutions and individual/groups above 18 years of age during the period 1st July 2021 to 30th September 2021. The broad theme was 'Transforming Human Lives in Urban Landscape' through PMAY-U mission.

The contest received an overwhelming response from across India, especially from PMAY-U beneficiaries, who enthusiastically participated in the competition by sharing their life transforming experiences through films made by themselves. A total of 34 participants have been selected under three categories for recognition. The winners of the contest will get a cash prize and a certificate of recognition. The 1st Prize carries a cash reward of ₹25,000, 2nd prize ₹20,000 and the 3rd prize ₹12,500. The winners' names have been uploaded on PMAY-U website (<https://pmay-urban.gov.in/anniversary/winners-contest-kka>).

PMAY-U field inspection module in dashboard was also launched on the occasion. The purpose is to assist visitors to inspect PMAY-U project sites/houses construction by beneficiaries with the help of just a mobile phone. The module can be used by the Ministry, Central Nodal Agencies, PMU members, State officials and respective SLTCs/CLTCs staff.

Addressing the event, Secretary, MoHUA, said that in the seven years of implementation of PMAY-U, with the concerted efforts put in by everyone associated with the Mission, a lot of achievements have been made and some more have to be fulfilled. Secretary, MoHUA urged the States/UTs to expedite construction work in their respective regions to fulfil the target of Housing for All. "I am hopeful everyone will work together and achieve the target," he added.

The States/UTs also celebrated the 7th anniversary of PMAY-U with much joy. Different activities such as interactions with PMAY-U beneficiaries, visit to PMAY-U houses, tree plantation drive, distribution of certificates, grih pravesh ceremonies, rangoli making, among other things were conducted to mark the day. At some places, PMAY-U beneficiaries were invited to celebrate the day by cutting cakes along with Mission officials.



Secretary, MoHUA reviews progress of Light House Projects

On 22nd June 2022, a meeting was chaired by Shri Manoj Joshi, Secretary, MoHUA, to review work progress of Light House Projects at five locations, namely, Rajkot, Indore, Lucknow, Ranchi & Agartala. Shri Kuldip Narayan, Joint Secretary & Mission Director, Housing For All, was present during the meeting along with other officers of MoHUA & concerned officials from LHP construction agencies.

At the outset, Secretary, MoHUA was briefed about the work done at sites through a presentation, after which he evaluated state-wise progress and discussed issues pertaining to construction activities, expected timeline of completion of projects, among other things.



Regular meetings, site visits are constantly undertaken by Ministry officials to monitor progress of LHPs. Telecast of undergoing work at LHP sites is also streamed live for close monitoring.

National Training Workshop on e-finance module, MIS, Geo-Tagging and PFMS



A 2-day National Training Workshop on e-finance module, MIS, Geo-Tagging and PFMS under PMAY- U was organised for officials of States/UTs under the chairmanship of Shri Kuldip Narayan, JS&MD, HFA, on 4th and 5th June 2022. On Day 1, Live demo of the e-finance module, PMAY-U dashboard, sessions on BhuvanHFA & BharatHFA mobile application and PMAY-U website were the topics discussed during the workshop. Shri RK Gautam Director, MoHUA and Shri Suvasish Das, Director, MoHUA and Ministry officials were also present at the workshop.



On the second day, a detailed demo presentation/hands-on training was provided by senior officials of NRSC, ISRO on BhuvanHFA mobile application, web-portal and dashboard. Demo presentation on e-finance module of PMAY-U was also given to all States/UTs by NIC.



JS&MD, HFA reviews implementation of PMAY-U in Varanasi



Shri Kuldip Narayan, JS&MD, HFA, MoHUA, visited Varanasi, Uttar Pradesh on 18th and 19th June 2022. He reviewed the progress of AHP & BLC projects under PMAY-U with the concerned officials of State Government. 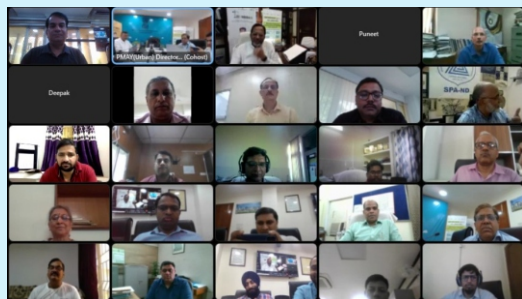
JS&MD, HFA monitors progress of Light House Project Rajkot

A review meeting to monitor progress of Light House Project (LHP) Rajkot was held on 8th June 2022 under the chairmanship of Shri Kuldip Narayan, JS&MD, HFA. Shri RK Gautam, Director, MoHUA, and other officials of the HFA Division were also present for the meeting, along with officers from Gujarat Government and that of construction agency.

Detailed discussions regarding construction developments and completion of project were held during the meeting. At LHP Rajkot, over 90% work has been completed and the project is nearing completion stage. Rajkot will be the second LHP to be inaugurated in some months' time after Chennai. Light House Project Chennai was inaugurated by Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi on 26th May 2022.



Lucknow turns host for webinar on e-Learning and webcasting of Light House Project for Technograhis



In March 2022, a series on 'e-Learning sessions and webcasting of LHP construction process' took off. As of now, nine such insightful sessions have been hosted by the Ministry for Technograhis and other stakeholders to disseminate knowledge about LHP technologies, construction processes

and how they can be replicated in Indian context. Technical sessions are organised in collaboration with BMTPC and GIZ, wherein the nitty-gritties of LHPs and technology specification are explained in detail to participants through live photos, videos and presentations.

During each session, the focus is on one LHP site. The last webinar was held in at Lucknow LHP site. The webinars are serving as learning and knowledge sharing platforms for all stakeholders interested in learning about innovative construction technologies.

The webinars have been receiving a warm welcome by stakeholders involved in building construction sector. Today, close to 35,000 stakeholders have enrolled as Technograhis and are learning the use of LHP technologies to promote their replication.

RACHNA training programme on innovative construction technologies & thermal comfort in affordable housing



MoHUA has come up with the concept of conducting training programmes and workshops by the name RACHNA with an aim to spread knowledge on Innovative Construction Technologies and Thermal Comfort in Affordable Housing.

RACHNA, which means Resilient, Affordable, Comfortable Housing with National Action, is a collaborative effort of MoHUA, Building Materials and Technology Promotion Council (BMTPC) and GIZ. The workshops are specifically designed for different groups of stakeholders, including urban practitioners, Government officials, builders, students and construction workers. Domain experts are invited to talk about the importance of fundamentals of thermal comfort, building materials, methods of construction for affordable housing and technology.

In the series, different trainings and awareness drives for various stakeholders, including Government officials, urban practitioners, construction workers, masons, contractors, housing technology experts, students and academicians are being hosted across the country. Some of the cities where RACHNA trainings have been organised are Chennai, Ranchi, Vadodara, Patna, Lucknow, New Delhi, Trivandrum, Indore, Agartala, Bengaluru, Bhubaneswar, Jaipur, Rajkot, Ahmedabad, Kolkata, Guwahati, Chandigarh, Bhubaneswar, Mumbai and Raipur. Trainings have also been organised at Demonstration Housing Projects (DHPs) and LHPs sites. Online trainings are also held.

The purpose is to host 75 training events under the Global Housing Technology Challenge-India (GHTC-India) under Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav (AKAM) for building sector stakeholders and Technograhis.

A glimpse of Technograhis visit to LHP Indore

Regular site visits are organised at LHP sites for Technograhis and other stakeholders interested in learning about the new technologies and their usage. Recently on 13th June 2022, approximately 30 students of Shri Govindram Seksaria Institute of Technology and Science (SGSITS) visited Light House Project location in Indore. The group was briefed about 'Prefabricated Sandwich Panel System' technology which is being used for construction of 1,024 LHP houses in Indore. Such engaging sessions for Technograhis have been helping in enriching their knowledge about building construction technologies and the housing project.



International Day of Yoga celebrations

On International Day of Yoga (21st June 2022), Hon'ble Union Minister for Housing & Urban Affairs Shri Hardeep Singh Puri took part in the celebrations from New Delhi's iconic Red Fort while Hon'ble Minister of State for Housing and Urban Affairs Shri Kaushal Kishore graced the occasion in Nagaland.

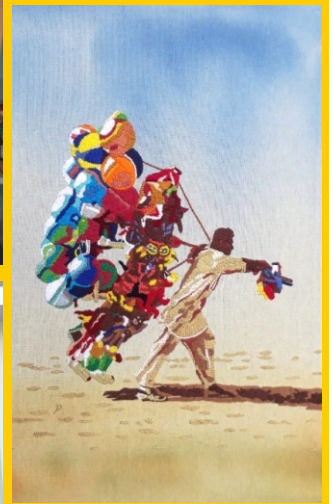


World Environment Day celebrated by States/UTs

PMAY-U providing financial security for better opportunities



PMAY-U has opened doors of opportunities for every beneficiary registered under the Mission. The millions of transformation stories are a testament to the fact that when a family gets a roof over its head, it gets a sense of safety, dignity and financial security. PMAY-U has empowered both women and men of the household with better opportunities. Such is the inspiring story of Smt Pratibhaben and her husband Shri Shrimali Dineshkumar Mafatlal, who reside in Gujarat's Anand. Shri Dineshbhai – as he is often called is a painter by profession and Smt Pratibhaben is an embroiderer.

Both Shri Dineshbhai and Smt Pratibhaben are truly blessed with exemplary artisan skills. They were able to improvise over it more after they got moved into their pucca house in sometime between 2019-2020. Shri Dineshbhai says, "Due to our poor living conditions earlier, I was not able to concentrate on my work. There was shortage of proper living space and in such a case, I could not afford to make a base to create any artwork." Smt. Pratibhaben too, just managed the house and could not support her husband in any form. Shri Dineshbhai adds that seeing the circumstances in which they lived, he did not receive huge orders. Later, he rented out a space to work, but the mounting expenses forced him to shut down work.

"I knew I have the skill, but I was not getting good opportunities. It was only after we got a pucca house under PMAY-U that opportunities knocked our door. When we built this house, I specifically got a separate room constructed for my work. Today, I paint without any hassles or tension. My wife has also got a chance to showcase her talent," Shri Dineshbhai explains.

He is associated with an art gallery in Delhi. Some of his works are displayed at government building in Gandhinagar and other parts of Gujarat. He proudly adds that he was also informed by a client that his work was also gifted to former Prime Minister Shri Atal Bihari Vajpayee. Shri Dineshbhai also takes individual orders and sells them directly to the clients. Smt Pratibhaben has also been part of some exhibitions in Mumbai and Ahmedabad where her artwork was displayed.

Their house is primarily run by Shri Dineshbhai's income. His parents also stay with the couple. He says that the house has turned out to be their lucky charm. Things are moving swiftly. The house is equipped with all basic amenities. Every house built under the Mission ensures dignity of living with access to basic civic amenities.
