Hon'ble Prime Minister launches 'Viksit Bharat Sankalp Yatra'

On 15th November 2023, Hon'ble Prime Minister Narendra Modi launched Viksit Bharat Sankalp Yatra (VBSY) from Khunti, Jharkhand. In urban areas, the nationwide Yatra was flagged off on 28th November 2023. The Yatra is being undertaken with the aim to achieve saturation of flagship schemes of the Government by ensuring that the benefits of the schemes reach the last mile.

Customised IEC (Information, Education and Communication) Vans with messages of Government's flagship welfare programmes are moving to different cities across the country to reach out to people and create awareness and providing benefits of welfare schemes.

The benefits include housing for the poor, sanitation facilities, essential financial services, electricity connections, access to LPG cylinders, food security, proper nutrition, healthcare, clean drinking water, etc.

Through various Jan Bhagidari activities, citizens are being informed about the different Government schemes and they are also getting to know about how they can enrol themselves for getting the benefits of the schemes. Camps like Ayushman Bharat camp, Aadhar Updation camp, Health camp, PM

SVANidhi camp and PM Ujjwala camp etc are being organised at the venues with the aim to ensure inclusivity and access to essential services for all segments of society. Beneficiaries of Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana – Urban, along with beneficiaries of other Schemes, are invited at the camp locations to share their transformation experience under 'Meri Kahaani Meri Zubaani'.



Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu inaugurates 13 AHP projects

On 20th November 2023, Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu Shri MK Stalin virtually inaugurated 4,272 tenements constructed under PMAY-U at 13 Affordable Housing in Partnership (AHP) project sites across 9 districts of the State. The cost of the projects is ₹ 453.67 crore.

In Tamil Nadu, 6.81 lakh houses have been sanctioned under PMAY-U, out of which 5.49 lakh houses have been completed and delivered to beneficiaries.



Hon'ble Chief Minister of Odisha inaugurates 3 Affordable Housing projects



Hon'ble Chief Minister of Odisha Shri Naveen Patnaik inaugurated three affordable housing projects constructed at Chandrasekhar, Shanti Nagar and Subudhipur in Bhubaneswar under PMAY-U on 20th November 2023. Over 1,700 beneficiaries have been allotted dwelling units in these projects.

In Odisha, 2.03 lakh houses have been sanctioned under PMAY-U, out of which 1.38 lakh houses have been completed and delivered to beneficiaries.

Secretary, MoHUA reviews progress of PMAY-U in Punjab



On 16th October 2023, Shri Manoj Joshi, Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA) chaired a meeting in Chandigarh to review the progress of Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana - Urban (PMAY-U) and other flagship Schemes of the Ministry in the State of Punjab. State Government officials and other officers associated with the different Missions were part of the review meeting. In Punjab, 1.32 lakh houses have been sanctioned under PMAY-U, out of which 1.13 lakh houses have been grounded for construction while over 76,000 have been completed and delivered to beneficiaries.

Whenever some relatives visited Smt. Geeta and her husband Shri Govind Paswan, they faced humiliation due to the place they lived in. Smt. Geeta puts it as, “Our relatives used to make fun of us and did not visit us. Every time we met, they used to tell us to construct a house, but they never understood that even we didn’t want to live like this, but since we did not have enough money, we were forced to live in such conditions.”

The family hails from Uttarakhand’s Dehradun and struggled to make both ends meet. However, today, they are living a life they always dreamt of. They have a permanent address, a pucca house and most importantly, Smt. Geeta is the owner of the house.

It hasn’t been an easy journey for Smt. Geeta and as she recalls the past years, she shares that they used to stay in a kutchra house which had just one room, a make-shift toilet and an open space outside which they had to cover by plastic sheet while bathing. “We needed a permanent shelter, but the amount my husband brought home as a taxi driver was not enough to take care of the household expenses, let alone address the growing needs my young children and also a house,” Smt. Geeta explains.

“We have three children, their education had to be taken care of, house expenses were mounting and four mouths were to be fed. I started working as a house-help to support my husband,” she shares, adding, “We also wanted to build a house – even if a small one, but which we could call our own.”

The deplorable condition of the house in which they were living was an inevitable burden on the family and they struggled every month. “My family was facing a lot of difficulties and we realised that only if we have our own house, things will function smoothly,” Smt. Geeta expresses, but she was not able to find any means to raise finances to start building a house.

It was around this time that she heard about Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana – Urban and believed that it was a God sent blessing. Smt. Geeta promptly applied for financial assistance under PMAY-U and after approvals, she got her home constructed. The Central Assistance from PMAY-U helped her in building the dream house. The family is now living in their own pucca house which has given them a better quality of life, especially to their children.

“It is a proud feeling to see your name outside the house. I feel happy to see my children living in a pucca house as my struggle was also theirs. A welfare scheme like PMAY-U is transforming lives of people with a permanent roof over their heads,” Smt. Geeta shares. She also says that the relatives who earlier used to look down upon them are now “jealous” of the massive transformation of the family and their pucca house.
