Hon'ble Prime Minister releases ₹ 1,001 crore to 1 lakh beneficiaries of PMAY-U 2.0 in Bihar

On the occasion of National Panchayati Raj Day on 24th April 2025, Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi inaugurated, laid the foundation stone and dedicated to the nation multiple development projects at a mega event held in Jhanjharpur of Madhubani district in Bihar. The initiatives spanned across key sectors of development, including housing. The event was also graced by Hon'ble Governor of Bihar Shri Arif Mohammed Khan, Hon'ble Chief Minister of Bihar Shri Nitish Kumar and several Union/State Ministers, public representatives and senior officials of the Central and State Governments.

During the event, Hon'ble Prime Minister released ₹1,001 crore to bank accounts of over 1 lakh new beneficiaries of Bihar under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana - Urban 2.0 (PMAY-U 2.0) as first instalment, thus empowering these families to begin construction of their dream of a pucca houses with dignity and stability.

Talking about Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana in Gramin and Urban areas, Hon'ble Prime Minister said, "The aim of this scheme is that no poor family in the country should be homeless, everyone should have a concrete roof over their head. In the coming years, 3 crores more concrete houses are going to be given to the poor. Today itself, about 1.5 lakh families of Bihar are entering their new pucca houses. Sanction letters for construction of new houses have also been given to 15 lakh poor families across the country. Out of these, three and a half lakh beneficiaries are from our Bihar only. Today itself, financial assistance has been sent to about 10 lakh poor families for their concrete houses. This includes 80 thousand rural families and one lakh urban families of Bihar."

Bihar is among the leading States behind the rapid implementation of PMAY-U 2.0. In pursuance to the Hon'ble Prime Minister's vision of Housing for All, the PMAY-U 2.0 Scheme caters to housing needs of 1 crore additional families belonging to Economically Weaker Section (EWS)/Low Income Group (LIG)/Middle Income



Group (MIG) segments who do not have a pucca house anywhere in the country. The families will get financial assistance by the Government to purchase or construct a house in urban areas.

PMAY-U 2.0 is being implemented through four verticals i.e., Beneficiary Led Construction (BLC), Affordable Housing in Partnership (AHP), Affordable Rental Housing (ARH) and Interest Subsidy Scheme (ISS), providing flexibility to the beneficiaries to avail benefits under any one vertical as per the preference or eligibility. Central Assistance up to ₹2.50 lakh per housing unit is provided.

Grih Pravesh of 54,000 PMAY-U houses held in presence of Hon'ble Prime Minister



At the event in Bihar, Hon'ble Prime Minister also participated in the ***grih pravesh*** of 54,000 already completed houses built under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana - Urban (PMAY-U). The day marked a milestone in the lives of these 54,000 families who entered their pucca houses with new hope and will continue to live in these houses which has all amenities to provide ease of living to them.



Notably, Bihar is among the top performers under PMAY-U. Out of the total approved 2.91 lakh houses, over 1.86 lakh have been handed over to the beneficiaries in the State.

PMAY-U was launched in 2015 to provide all-weather pucca houses to all eligible beneficiaries in the urban areas. Under the Scheme, more than 116.97 lakh houses have been sanctioned while more than 92.60 lakh houses have already been constructed and delivered to the beneficiaries.



Hon'ble Minister, MoHUA reviews progress of PMAY-U in Rajasthan



On 29th April 2025, Hon'ble Minister for Housing and Urban Affairs, Shri Manohar Lal held a review meeting in Jaipur in the presence of Hon'ble Chief Minister of Rajasthan, Shri Bhajan Lal to assess the urban development projects like Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana – Urban, Swachh Bharat Mission, AMRUT 2.0 among others. In the State of Rajasthan, under PMAY-U, 2.97 Lakh houses have been approved, out of which 2.27 Lakh have already been constructed and delivered to beneficiaries. Under PMAY-U 2.0 23,882 new houses have also been approved in 1st CSMC meeting held on 20th March 2025.

Hon'ble Minister, MoHUA & Hon'ble Chief Minister of Goa review progress of urban development Schemes in Panaji



Hon'ble Minister for Housing and Urban Affairs, Shri Manohar Lal held a meeting with Hon'ble Chief Minister of Goa, Shri Pramod Sawant in Panaji on 13th May 2025 to review the implementation and progress of key urban development initiatives and infrastructure projects in the State. Hon'ble Minister reviewed the comprehensive development plans of urban schemes of MoHUA, including PMAY-U 2.0.

In the spirit of cooperative federalism, the Centre and the State are working closely to expedite priority projects for the overall development of the State and are also coordinating to resolve

the major challenges and pending issues. The Hon'ble Minister emphasised the need to develop, improve infrastructure and promote sustainable urbanisation through strategic planning and public-private partnerships.

With respect to PMAY-U 2.0, the Hon'ble Minister directed the State officials to submit proposals for construction of houses, inform and educate citizens about the Scheme so that maximum eligible families benefit from it.

Hon'ble Minister said that Goa, as a prominent tourist hub and a rapidly growing State, is witnessing significant progress in urban development. He provided guidelines for effective planning and proper implementation of urban schemes under MoHUA to promote development and enhance ease of living for the people.

Secretary, MoHUA chairs CSMC meetings under PMAY-U 2.0

Proposals for construction of about 4.75 lakh houses have been approved at the first and second meetings of Central Sanctioning and Monitoring Committee (CSMC) under PMAY-U 2.0 held on 20th March and 17th April 2025. The meetings were chaired by Shri Srinivas Katikithala, Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA). Shri Kuldip Narayan, Joint Secretary & Mission Director (JS&MD), Housing for All (HFA), Senior officers from States/UTs, State/UT Mission Directors, senior officials of the Ministry and officers from States/UTs were also present via physical and virtual modes.

A total of 4,75,115 houses have been approved under Beneficiary Led Construction (BLC) and Affordable Housing in Partnership (AHP) components of PMAY-U 2.0 in 14 States/UTs, namely Andhra Pradesh,



Arunachal Pradesh, Bihar, Chhattisgarh, Gujarat, Haryana, Jammu & Kashmir, Jharkhand, Odisha, Puducherry, Punjab, Rajasthan, Telangana and Uttar Pradesh.

To promote inclusiveness and equality, the houses have been sanctioned in the name of women and for beneficiaries belonging to SC/ST, OBC and other underprivileged groups.

PMAY-U 2.0 ensure equity across different segments of population by addressing the housing requirements of slum dwellers, SC/ST, minorities, widows, Persons with Disabilities and other underprivileged sections of the society. Special focus is being given to Safai Karmi, street vendors identified under PMSVANidhi Scheme and different artisans under Pradhan Mantri-Vishwakarma Scheme, anganwadi workers, building and other construction workers, residents of slums/chawls and other groups identified during the operation of Scheme

JS&MD, HFA visits vacant JnNURM houses in Delhi



Shri Kuldeep Narayan, JS&MD, HFA conducted a visit to vacant Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission (JnNURM) houses in New Delhi on 4th April 2025 to assess the usage of these houses and conditions of liveability. Shri RK Gautam, Deputy Director General (DDG), HFA, senior officials from MoHUA, Building Materials and Technology Promotion Council (BMTPC) and Central Public Works Department (CPWD) also conducted the site visits in different locations.

JS&MD, HFA reviews progress of PMAY-U and PMAY-U 2.0

Shri Kuldeep Narayan, JS&MD, Housing for All conducted multiple meetings in the month of April to have a comprehensive review of the progress of PMAY-U and PMAY-U 2.0 with different States/UTs. The review meetings focused on completion status of the already

sanctioned projects under PMAY-U, fund disbursement and utilisation, occupancy status of completed houses and geo-tagging status of projects. States/UTs were directed to expedite the grounding, completion and occupancy of houses, geo-tagging of projects and ensure timely release of funds.



PMAY-U 2.0, its implementation and targets were also discussed in detail. 4.75 lakh houses have already been sanctioned under the Scheme. States/UTs are actively engaging with prospective beneficiaries to make them aware about PMAY-U 2.0 so that more and more families can get a pucca roof over their head.

DDG, HFA chairs roundtable discussion on Innovations in Urban Housing in Jaipur



Shri RK Gautam, DDG, Housing for All, chaired a roundtable discussion on 'Innovations in Urban Housing' at the 12th Regional 3R & Circular Economy Forum in Asia and the Pacific, held in March 2025 in Jaipur, Rajasthan. The platform brought together officials from various States, housing experts to deliberate and exchange ideas on best practices for affordable housing, incentivizing private investment in the affordable housing sector and innovative models for affordable rental housing. The participants shared their views on the best practices which can provide fillip to affordable housing and rental housing ecosystem under PMAY-U 2.0.

Ghar Hua Apna, Pura Hua Sapna

PMAY-U has truly been a blessing for Smt Rathod Bhikhiben Kantibhai and she hopes that like them, many other families who do not have a pucca house, are benefitted. *"By virtue of this house, I have gained respect in my family, my relatives and neighbourhood. Nobody wanted to build a relationship with us looking at our poor living conditions. However, since I have built a house for myself, my standard of living has elevated and people also respect me now,"* Smt Rathod says.

Smt Rathod is a widow. She lives in the pucca house with her two sons and one daughter in Navsari, Gujarat. Her daughter is going to get married soon and the proud mother credits the PMAY-U scheme behind her daughter's alliance. Recounting the experiences she faced while finding alliances for her daughter's marriage, she explained, *"Looking at the condition of our old house, I found it very difficult to find a groom for my daughter. We lived in a kutchha house, no one came to our house. It was disturbing time to face rejections. But once our pucca house got constructed, I found a good match for my daughter. He earns well, has a house and my daughter will be happy. What more does a mother want?"*

Smt Rathod Bhikhiben Kantibhai's experience highlights the transformative impact of PMAY-U Scheme on individuals and families. PMAY-U has not only provided crores of families with secured pucca roof but has also brought dignity in their lives.

The struggles seemed to never end for Smt Prema Sonekar, a single mother to two children. Smt Sonekar got divorced some years ago and since then, she has been living alone with her children without any support. Financial conditions forced them to live in a waste disposal area as she did not have money to rent a small place.

"As a mother it used to break my heart to see my children suffering. I had promised myself that I would build a house for them where they would live comfortably and no one would ask them to vacate it," says Smt Sonekar, who works as a Swachhta didi at Rajnandgaon. While on work, the Nagar Nigam officials informed her and other workers about Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana - Urban. This prompted her to take a step forward in fulfilling her dream of having an own house. Smt Sonekar had brought land in 2020 and by 2022, she started the construction of her house. The construction of her house got completed in 2024.

"I am proud of my achievements and I am filled with gratitude when I see my name outside the house. My children are proud of me too. Their smiles, when we entered our house for the first time, made me forget all

my miseries. I have spent years struggling to get a roof over my head and today, I am an owner of a pucca house. The house belongs to my children. We have no one to look after us and God forbid if something happens to me, the house will protect them," Smt Sonekar shares.

Smt Sonekar expresses her gratitude to the Government of India for providing financial assistance to construct her house which has given her a recognition in society and a safe and secured space to lead her life.

"Meri beti ki dua qubool ho gai hai," says Smt Shaista Parveen Sarfaraz Shaikh when asked to describe her house. Smt Shaista, daughter-in-law of PMAY-U beneficiary, Smt Shakilabano Mohammad Akram and her family stay in Bhusawal, Maharashtra. They did not have a pucca house of their own and

whenever the kid used to visit her maternal grandmother's house, a pucca one, she used to ask the mother when will they have a pucca house. Recalling the past incidents, Smt Shaista said, *"The only question my daughter asked me when we used to visit my mother's house was when we would live in a house like this, and unfortunately, I did not have an answer to it."*

The family was suffering in a dilapidated kutcha house. The struggles were part of their everyday life, especially for the women of the household and kids. Financial conditions were also a matter of concern for them. Though she had done a beautician course, she did not have means to pursue the profession which would also generate additional family income.

PMAY-U, however, opened doors of opportunities for them. Life has now changed drastically for the family. *"We feel complete and are extremely happy, at the same time grateful to the Government for fulfilling our housing dream. My children, especially my daughter, has seen our struggles in the kutcha house. We had no amenities there, I used to fetch water from a far-off place, there was no toilet. Nobody came to our house looking at our living conditions. The rainy season was painful, to say the least. The pucca house has changed everything for us. My children have a proper room to study, a place to call their own. Relatives visit us, we are no more worried about the weather conditions as we have a safe shelter. There is regular water supply, toilet facility and a separate kitchen,"* Smt Shaista explains in detail.

She also runs a beauty parlour from home while her husband owns a salon. *"The house allowed me to pursue my dream of having a parlour and I also take orders for stitching clothes. Since I do not have to go out for work, I can manage my house properly and have time for everything,"* Smt Shaista adds.

Activities in States

Chhattisgarh

On 25th April 2025, Hon'ble Governor of Chhattisgarh Shri Ramen Deka visited the house of Shri Surji Korwa, a PMAY-U beneficiary from Balrampur. The Hon'ble Governor observed the quality of the house, their living conditions and spoke to the beneficiary about their transformation. Hon'ble Governor felicitated the beneficiary and praised Nagar Palika Parishad Balrampur for the successful implementation of the scheme. He directed the concerned officials to provide housing to the remaining eligible beneficiaries, so that more and more needy citizens can get benefits of the Scheme and their living conditions are improved.



Additionally, about 105 families in Bhilai were allotted pucca houses under PMAY-U through a transparent lottery system. The eligible beneficiaries who had deposited 10% of the total house cost took part in the lottery. These houses are located at different locations across the city. The ground floors in the buildings have been allotted to differently-abled individuals.

The administration has urged more citizens to apply for the Scheme and become owners of pucca houses.

Assam

The State of Assam has been organising periodical awareness programmes and meetings in designated Urban Local Bodies for disseminating information regarding Scheme benefits and its eligibility. Such awareness programmes aim to create awareness among the eligible beneficiaries.

Recently, the first Meeting of State Level Sanctioning and Monitoring Committee (SLSMC) under PMAY-U 2.0 was held under the chairmanship of Chief Secretary, Government of Assam. Commissioner & Secretary, Department of Housing & Urban Affairs, State Mission Director (PMAY-U) along with members of the committee also attended the meeting. The Chairperson reviewed the overall status of the applications received through the Unified Web Portal of PMAY-U 2.0 and overall uptake of PMAY-U in Assam.

In the ULBs, District Level Sanctioning and Monitoring Committee Meetings were also conducted in the presence of respective District Commissioners. The purpose of the meeting is to submit eligible beneficiaries' list that have been verified in the Unified Web Portal of PMAY-U 2.0.



Maharashtra

The ownership of 160 flats under the Affordable Housing in Partnership (AHP-PPP) in Sangli Miraj and Kupwad City Municipal Corporation were handed over to beneficiaries by Hon'ble Minister of Higher and Technical Education, Government of Maharashtra, Shri Chandrakant Patil. The distribution of keys of individual houses to the beneficiaries was conducted by Commissioner and the Deputy Commissioner along with other officers.



Meanwhile in context to PMAY-U 2.0, workshops are also being organised to understand the problems faced by the beneficiaries and officials are guiding them through the application process and other related information.

Rajasthan

Rajasthan



Review and monitoring of PMAY-U & PMAY-U 2.0

A review meeting was conducted by District Collectors to assess the progress of PMAY-U Scheme, evaluate the status of PMAY-U 2.0 projects in ULBs and various districts in the State of Rajasthan so that target is achieved timely.
