Hon'ble Prime Minister's visit to Bihar: Inauguration of 6,684 PMAY-U houses, transfer of first instalment of 536 crore to beneficiaries under PMAY-U 2.0

In a major boost to infrastructure and socioeconomic development in Bihar, Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi inaugurated and laid the foundation stone of multiple development projects worth over ₹5,200 crore in Siwan on 20th June 2025. The initiatives spanned across various sector, including housing. Hon'ble Governor of Bihar, Shri Arif Mohammad Khan, Hon'ble Chief Minister of Bihar, Shri Nitish Kumar, several Union and State Ministers, MPs and MLAs also graced the occasion.



PMAY-U PROGRESS





























During the event, Hon'ble Prime Minister participated in the grih pravesh ceremony of 6,684 already completed PMAY-U houses across Bihar and handed over the house keys to a few beneficiaries to mark the occasion. The housing dreams of these 6000+ families were finally fulfilled where they can now lead a respectable and safe life.

Meanwhile, under PMAY-U 2.0, Hon'ble Prime Minister released the first instalment of ₹536.66 crore to bank accounts of 53,666 new beneficiaries.



Speaking at the occasion about PMAY scheme, Hon'ble Prime Minister said, "More than 57 lakh houses have been built in Bihar under the Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana. Here in Siwan district also, more than one lakh ten thousand houses of the poor have been built, I am talking about one district and this work is continuing continuously. Even today, instalments for houses have been issued for more than 50 thousand families of Bihar. And do you know what brings double happiness for me? Most of these houses are in the name of mothers and sisters. My sisters and daughters who





never had any property in their name are now becoming owners of their houses. Our government is providing free ration, electricity and water facilities along with houses."

The State of Bihar has been one of the frontrunners in the implementation of PMAY-U. Out of the 2.91 lakh houses approved under the Scheme, 1.88 lakh houses have already been completed and handed over to the beneficiaries. Under PMAY-U 2.0, More than 1.53 lakh houses have been sanctioned.

Inauguration of over 22,000 PMAY-U houses by Hon'ble Prime Minister in Gujarat





In an event in Gandhinagar on 27th May 2025, Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi, inaugurated 22,055 pucca houses constructed under PMAY-U in different cities of Gujarat. Hon'ble Governor of Gujarat, Shri Acharya Devvrat, Hon'ble Chief Minister, Shri Bhupendrabhai Patel, Hon'ble Minister for Housing and Urban Affairs, Shri Manohar Lal, Hon'ble Minister of Jal Shakti, Shri CR Patil were also present on the occasion.

Out of these 22,055 houses, 3,894 are constructed under AHP vertical of the Scheme while 18,161 are pucca houses under BLC vertical. The houses are built at a cost of ₹1,006 crore.






Exhibition on PMAY-U in Bhopal visited by Hon'ble Prime Minister

meeting of Eastern Zonal Council was attended by Hon'ble Chief Minister of Jharkhand, Shri Hemant Soren, Hon'ble Chief Minister of Odisha, Shri Mohan Charan Majhi, Hon'ble Deputy Chief Minister of Bihar, Shri Samrat Choudhary and Hon'ble Finance Minister of West Bengal Smt Chandrima Bhattacharya. Senior ministers from the member States, the Union Home Secretary, the Secretary of the Inter-State Council Secretariat, Chief Secretaries of the member States, and other senior officials from the States and Central Ministries and departments also participated in the meetings.

A wide range of topics were discussed in the meetings, including matters of national importance and issues of common interest at the regional level including nutrition, education, health, power, urban planning and strengthening of cooperative systems. Progress of PMAY-U in the member States was also reviewed. Shri RK Gautam, Deputy Director General, Housing for All, represented the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA) in both the meetings.

Hon'ble Minister, MoHUA chairs meeting of Urban Development Ministers in New Delhi



A meeting of Urban Development Ministers was held in New Delhi on 17th July 2025, in the esteemed presence of Shri Manohar Lal, Hon'ble Minister for Housing and Urban Affairs, Shri Tokhan Sahu, Hon'ble Minister of State for Housing and Urban Affairs. The meeting was attended by Urban Development Ministers from various States/UTs, Shri Srinivas Katikithala, Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs, Urban Development Secretaries from States/UTs, Principal Secretaries and senior officials from the Ministry.

The event highlighted key initiatives undertaken by the different States/UTs on urban development and governance with respect to Swachhata, affordable housing, urban transport system, infrastructure, water security, among others for a holistic approach to urban governance and sustainable development. The meeting provided a platform to Ministers, policymakers, experts and representatives to share best practices, models, combine ideas and initiatives from multiple stakeholders and insights from various regions for India's urban future, at the National and State/UT levels.



At the meeting, Smt Pratima Bagri, Hon'ble Minister of State, Urban Development and Housing Department, Madhya Pradesh, shared the Best Practice adopted by the State in implementation of PMAY-U by including EWS in affordable housing ecosystem and empowerment of women through the Scheme.

She highlighted the initiative of tripartite agreement, inclusion of EWS in formal financial system, increasing affordability for EWS, cross subsidisation, inclusive urban housing, providing patta among others.

The Hon'ble Minister added that the PMAY-U 2.0 scheme is being converged with State Government schemes to provide affordable housing benefits to different women beneficiaries.

Meanwhile, a brainstorming session on 'Housing and Land related Matters' with Secretaries, Mission Directors from different States, sector experts was moderated by Shri Kuldip Narayan, JS&MD, 'Housing for All' Mission and Shri Ravi Arora, JS. MoHUA.



A wide range of topics such as future roadmap for enhancing supply of affordable housing in the country, incentives for promotion of private participation, developing rental housing ecosystem, innovative financing models for affordable housing, exploring effective land



aggregation strategies was broadly discussed, along with their expected outcomes like formulation of futuristic housing policy and compilation of replicable best practices and innovations.

In the concluding session, a State-wise discussion on PMAY-U and other MoHUA Schemes was chaired by Hon'ble Minister for Housing and Urban Affairs with Urban Development Ministers from different States/UTs. During the session, Hon'ble Minister spoke about working on achieving targets on completion of pucca houses, prioritising group housing projects (Affordable Housing in Partnership vertical of PMAY-U) and Affordable Rental Housing for ease of living for industrial workers, investment by private sector for promoting affordable housing and preparation of affordable housing policy by States.

Hon'ble Minister also sought suggestions from the different Ministers, stakeholders on better & rapid implementation of PMAY-U and PMAY-U 2.0.





65,000 beneficiaries receive benefits of PMAY-U by Hon'ble Chief Minister of Madhya Pradesh

At the 'Madhya Pradesh Growth Conclave - Building the Cities of Tomorrow' event held on 11th July 2025 in Indore, Hon'ble Chief Minister of Madhya Pradesh, Dr Mohan Yadav distributed benefits worth ₹2,799.26 crore under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana - Urban to more than 65,000 beneficiaries of the scheme virtually. On the occasion, grih pravesh of more than 45,503 completed houses under PMAY-U was organised, while acceptance letters were given to 19,541 PMAY-U 2.0 beneficiaries.

At the different ULBs, the beneficiaries were handed over to the keys to their houses and the acceptance letters.

At an event in Kotputli district on 4th July 2025, Hon'ble Chief Minister of Rajasthan, Shri Bhajanlal Sharma released ₹52.50 lakh as different instalments under PMAY-U. The funds were distributed to 144 beneficiaries, furthering the Government's commitment to providing affordable housing and improving living standards for eligible beneficiaries living in urban areas.

In a bid to boost urban growth in Jammu & Kashmir, Hon'ble Minister for Housing and Urban Affairs, Shri Manohar Lal conduced a detailed meeting with Hon'ble Chief Minister Shri Omar Abdullah in Srinagar on 12th June 2025 to review the implementation and progress of key urban Missions of MoHUA, including PMAY-U, in the Union Territory. The meeting focused on accelerating urban development, building and strengthening infrastructure, promoting inclusive growth of cities and other key issues in the Union Territory (UT). It was also attended by senior officials of the Central and Union Territory Governments.

The meeting centred on urban development initiatives/projects concerning better infrastructure, affordable housing, smart city initiatives, inclusive planning, improved sanitation, transport concerning growth & inclusive development of J&K.

The Hon'ble Minister said that the people of Jammu & Kashmir are benefiting from all the urban schemes of the Central Government and the Centre and the UT of Jammu & Kashmir are working in close coordination upholding the spirit of cooperative federalism to expedite the schemes and projects for overall inclusive development of the State.



While reviewing each scheme in detail, he emphasized the need to develop and improve infrastructure framework and promote sustainable urbanization through strategic planning and public-private partnership.

Regarding PMAY-U 2.0, it was observed that more than 19,000 applications have been submitted on the integrated web portal while in-principle permission has already been granted by the Ministry for construction of 10,000 pucca houses. Therefore, the UT administration was directed to fast-track and verify beneficiary applications so that maximum eligible families can avail the benefit of affordable housing.

Under PMAY-U, construction of houses under various stages of construction was asked to be expedited.

The Hon'ble Minister said that Jammu & Kashmir is an integral part of India and is rapidly developing with remarkable progress in urban development. He laid down guidelines to ensure effective planning and efficient implementation of urban schemes under the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs to spur development and make life easier for the people of Jammu & Kashmir.

2.35 Lakh additional houses under PMAY-U 2.0 approved by Secretary, MoHUA during 3rd meeting of CSMC



Over 2.35 Lakh houses were approved for construction under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana – Urban 2.0 (PMAY-U 2.0) during the third meeting of Central Sanctioning and Monitoring Committee (CSMC) held on 18th June 2025 under the chairmanship of Shri Srinivas Katikithala, Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA).

The meeting was attended by Shri Kuldip Narayan, Joint Secretary & Mission Director (JS&MD), Housing for All (HFA), Principal Secretaries from States/UTs, PMAY-U Mission Directors from different States/UTs and senior officials of the Ministry. The total houses approved are 2,34,864 in nine States namely, Assam, Bihar, Chhattisgarh, Gujarat, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Odisha, Rajasthan and Uttar Pradesh.

PMAY-U 2.0 is being implemented through four verticals – Beneficiary Led Construction (BLC), Affordable Housing in Partnership (AHP), Affordable Rental Housing (ARH) and Interest Subsidy Scheme (ISS). The houses approved in the CSMC meeting are under BLC and AHP verticals of the Scheme. So far, the total number of houses sanctioned under PMAY-U 2.0 is 7,09,979.

During the meeting, Secretary, MoHUA directed the larger States to prepare affordable housing policy and bring the proposals under AHP vertical of PMAY-U 2.0. He added that States/UTs may study the affordable housing policy of the State of Maharashtra and adapt it according to their local requirements. States/UTs were also advised to identify and attach beneficiaries under the AHP vertical at initial phase of approval to avoid unoccupancy issues at a later stage.

JS&MD, HFA advised the States/UTs to complete verification and attachment of beneficiaries of applications received on unified web portal of PMAY-U 2.0. He also asked the States/UTs to give priority to beneficiaries from the Special Focus Group.

Under PMAY-U 2.0, 1 crore families will be provided financial assistance to construct or purchase a pucca house in urban areas. The Scheme focusses on



upliftment of poor and middle-class families by giving them secured houses to focus on the betterment of their lives. Individuals/families, who do not own a pucca house anywhere in the country, are eligible to purchase or construct a house under PMAY-U 2.0. Central Assistance of up to ₹2.50 lakh per housing unit is provided.

Eligible individuals can apply for the Scheme directly through https://pmay-urban.gov.in/ or contact their ULB for assistance.

Implementation of PMAY-U & PMAY-U reviewed by JS&MD, HFA

Shri Kuldip Narayan, Joint Secretary and Mission Director, Housing for All Mission, chaired a meeting in Lucknow on 4th July 2025 to review the implementation status of PMAY-U and PMAY-U 2.0 in Uttar Pradesh. The meeting was attended by Ms. Apoorva Dubey, Director, State Urban Development Agency (SUDA), senior officials from the State Government and representatives from Lucknow Development Authority, among others. The discussions focused on accelerating the implementation status of PMAY-U in the State by expediting construction, addressing implementation issues to ensure timely delivery of pucca houses to beneficiaries.





Uttar Pradesh is among the top performing States in implementation of PMAY-U & PMAY-U 2.0. Lucknow is also among the six cities where Light House Projects have been built using innovative construction technologies.

Meanwhile, the progress of PMAY-U and PMAY-U 2.0 in Udaipur Division (includes 7 districts) of Rajasthan was reviewed by JS&MD, HFA in Udaipur on 14th July 2025. Shri Pradeep Kumar Garg, Project Director (Housing) RUDSICO, senior officials from Udaipur Development Authority, Nagar Nigam and Executive Officers of Urban Local Bodies of Udaipur Zone participated in the meeting.



Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana – Urban, a vision that took root a decade ago, has since touched crores of lives. We recently marked 10 transformative years of PMAY-U scheme. In the past one decade, the Scheme just didn't deliver pucca houses, but also delivered hope and opportunities along. More than 93.61 lakh families have got access to a safe place to call home. 10 years of PMAY-U: A decade of transformation, a change forever

'Housing for All' Mission - Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (Urban) completed 10 years of its implementation in June 2025. Launched in June 2015, the Scheme has turned the dream of owning a pucca house into a reality for crores of urban families across the nation. In the last 10 years, the Scheme has not only empowered the poor and the marginalized section of society with a dignified place of living, but also promoted women empowerment by ensuring ownership of houses in the name of female member of the household or in joint name and has also improved the quality of life for families by giving them access to better health, education and livelihood opportunities.

On the occasion, Secretary, MoHUA released a book depicting transformation of PMAY-U beneficiaries through a pucca house.

As of date, around 1.20 crore houses have been sanctioned under the Scheme while more than 93.61 lakh houses have already been completed and delivered to beneficiaries. It includes 7.10 lakh houses sanctioned under PMAY-U 2.0. Out of the total approved Central Assistance of ₹2.01 lakh crore, ₹1.71 lakh crore has been released. Owing to the magnitude at which PMAY-U has been implemented, the Scheme is among the largest housing programmes in the world.

Activities in States/UTs

Assam

To spread knowledge about the benefits of PMAY-U 2.0 scheme, the State has been holding regular awareness campaigns and meetings in ULBs and Development Authorities. The goal of these awareness campaigns is to raise awareness among the eligible beneficiaries.

- Review meetings under PMAY-U and PMAY-U 2.0: Review meetings are being held under the chairmanship of State Mission Director in the presence of Executive Officers, Project Directors and City Project Managers. The officials were directed to work in close coordination with chairpersons of ULBs and Development Authorities for successful implementation of PMAY-U 2.0 and completion of the pending houses under PMAY-U. The City Project Managers were directed to regularly visit the houses and ensure geo-tagging and attachment.
- Online facilitation centre for PMAYU-2.0: At Silchar ULB, PMAY-U 2.0 online application facilitation centre has been set up with the goal to help the beneficiaries choose the appropriate scheme component based on their eligibility and needs.
- Field visit under PMAY-U: The Project Director at Barpeta conducted a field visit to the Barpeta Development Authority to oversee the progress of PMAY-U projects and provide guidance to officials.







He reviewed the progress of the scheme and held discussions on timely completion of houses.

- Ward level meetings: Ward level meetings were organised under Tinsukia Urban Local Body in Makum and Panitola with the primary objective to inform beneficiaries about PMAY-U 2.0 benefits and about the online application process. Direct interaction with beneficiaries helped address their queries and concerns, ensuring they were wellinformed about the scheme.
- Beneficiary appreciation letters: PMAY-U beneficiaries have written individual letters to the Hon'ble Prime Minister and Hon'ble Chief Minister of Assam for receiving subsidy under the Beneficiary Led Construction vertical of PMAY-U.

Nagaland

 A one-day orientation programme on PMAY-U 2.0 was held in June 2025 with stakeholders in Chiephobozou and Niuland towns. The information about the scheme was briefed to the stakeholders by specialists

Madhya Pradesh

of PMAY-U 2.0, the State of Madhya Pradesh has started a special campaign 'Mission Sabko Awas' from 5th June to 31st August 2025. In the first phase of the campaign, applications received till 31st May 2025 are targeted to receive benefits under the scheme.



A two-day social audit programme was conducted at the Thandla Municipal Council during which the team interacted with the beneficiaries to understand how the scheme has changed their lives. They also visited completed houses of BLC beneficiaries and heard their inspiring life-transformation stories. The president of the Municipal Council, Councillors from various wards, the Chief Municipal Officer, Engineers,

ULB officials, women from Self-Help Groups, anganwadi workers, and a large number of beneficiaries were present participated in the programme.

A meeting of the State Level Banking Committee (SLBC) was held under the chairmanship of Commissioner of the Urban Administration and Development Department (UADD), Madhya Pradesh, Shri Sanket Bhondve during which the progress of the Interest Subsidy Scheme (ISS) of PMAY-U 2.0 was reviewed and instructions were given to provide benefits to maximum eligible beneficiaries.

Meanwhile in Jabalpur, a detailed review meeting of PMAY-U was held by Commissioner, UADD.



Rajasthan



- A review meeting was organised to review the progress of PMAY-U and PMAY-U 2.0 to understand the issues faced at ULB level in implementation of the scheme and to allot targets for backto-back monitoring. The meeting was attended by divisional resident managers and State Level Technical Cell.
- Another review meeting was held by District Collectors to review and approve proposals under PMAY-U 2.0, ensuring compliance as per guidelines, including beneficiary selection and its implementation plans. The progress of PMAY-U was simultaneously held. The meetings ensure transparency in the approval process, verify compliance with PMAY-U guidelines and help in sanctioning projects in a timely manner.

The District Collectors' meetings play a crucial role in ensuring that PMAY-U 2.0 projects are implemented in accordance with guidelines, promoting transparency and accountability.

 A State Level Bankers meet was organized under the chairmanship of Executive Director RUDSICO and Project Director Housing for ISS vertical of PMAY-U 2.0. Approximately, 40 bankers participated in the meeting and discussed about the scheme, particularly ISS and to ensure the effective implementation of ISS, ultimately benefiting beneficiaries and promoting affordable housing.

The objectives of a bankers' meet were:

- I. **Discussing scheme implementation:** Reviewing progress, addressing challenges, and streamlining the implementation process of ISS.
- ii. **Enhancing collaboration:** Fostering cooperation among banks, government agencies and other stakeholders to ensure seamless delivery of benefits to beneficiaries.
- iii. **Addressing bottlenecks:** Identifying and resolving issues hindering the scheme's effectiveness, such as credit access, interest subsidy, and loan processing.
- iv. **Improving awareness:** Educating bankers and stakeholders about the scheme's benefits, eligibility criteria, and application processes to increase outreach and impact.
- v. **Streamlining processes:** Standardizing procedures and reducing paperwork to facilitate faster loan approvals and disbursals.
- vi. **Monitoring progress:** Tracking key performance indicators (KPIs) and evaluating the scheme's success in achieving its objectives.
