Hon'ble Minister for Housing and Urban Affairs inaugurates National Urban Conclave in New Delhi



Hon'ble Minister for Housing and Urban Affairs, Shri Manohar Lal, inaugurated the National Urban Conclave 2025 in New Delhi on 8th November 2025. The two-day conclave brought together Ministers from States/UTs and participants from various domains, including policymakers, urban planners, experts and stakeholders to deliberate on the theme "Sustainable Urban Development and Governance" through intensive brainstorming sessions across six thematic areas.

On the occasion, the Union Minister also inaugurated the 'Viksit Bharat City' exhibition, which brought to life the vision of a truly developed, vibrant, inclusive, sustainable, and future-ready Indian city. The exhibition showcased innovative urban planning models, smart technologies, and citizen-centric infrastructure implemented across Indian cities.

Speaking on the occasion, the Hon'ble Minister emphasized that India's urban transformation must be driven by sustainability, inclusivity, and innovation and stressed on building cleaner, greener and more liveable cities, aligning with the vision of Viksit Bharat. He reaffirmed that planned and coordinated urban development is essential to ensure holistic growth and an improved quality of life for citizens.

The Hon'ble Minister also shared how Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana - Urban (PMAY-U) has fulfilled the housing dreams of crores of families and under 2.0 version of the scheme, additional 1 crore urban families will be financially supported by the Government to construct or purchase their houses. He added that the scheme is also addressing the rental housing needs of the urban migrants to provide ease of living to them.

Meanwhile, Secretary, MoHUA underlined the importance of coordinated governance and institutional learning in realizing sustainable urban development. He said that the Conclave provides a valuable platform for city leaders and experts to share experiences and co-create solutions for the urban future of India.



Hon'ble Minister of State (MoS) for Housing and Urban Affairs, Shri Tokhan Sahu culminated the National Urban Conclave on 9th November 2025. The second day of the conclave continued the momentum of strategising ideas and approaches to advancing the vision for Viksit Bharat 2047.

Resonating with the commitment to advancing the Viksit Bharat 2047 vision, Hon'ble MoS articulated "we are moving beyond the model of poverty alleviation towards one of empowerment and entrepreneurship. To sustain this transformation, we must maintain coordination and commitment among the Centre, States/UTs/ULBs and the private sector."

On Day 2 of the National Urban Conclave, panel discussions on different schemes of MoHUA were held, including that on "Housing Ecosystem – Making Housing Accessible to Everyone".

Shri Kuldip Narayan, Joint Secretary and Mission Director (JS &MD), Housing for All, set the context by emphasizing the need to create affordable housing opportunities for EWS/LIG segments and also highlighted the importance of developing a robust rental housing framework to ensure inclusivity and a dignified living for different sections of society. He underlined the vision of building an equitable society where everyone has a roof over their head.



JS&MD further called for ideas to strengthen the construction technology ecosystem for faster delivery of houses and ensure sustainable development.

The discussion witnessed participation of urban development experts, policymakers who shared their insights on exploring a comprehensive housing ecosystem approach to ensure inclusive, affordable and sustainable housing for all. The experts presented a roadmap for private sector participation, land and Infrastructure reforms, strengthening rental housing, enhancing infrastructure financing and expanding affordable housing access.

The outcomes of deliberations during National Urban Conclave will provide actionable insights for India's roadmap to building inclusive, resilient, and well-governed cities.

The second regional meeting of Urban Development Ministers was held in Hyderabad on 18th November 2025 under the chairmanship of Shri Manohar Lal, Hon'ble Minister for Housing and Urban Affairs. The meeting was also attended by Shri Anumula Revanth Reddy, Hon'ble Chief Minister of Telangana. The meeting brought together Urban Development Ministers and senior level officials including Additional Chief Secretaries, Principal Secretaries and Secretaries from the South-West States and Union Territories, namely Andhra Pradesh, Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu, Goa, Gujarat, Maharashtra and Telangana.

In the opening remarks, Hon'ble Union Minister said, "Cities are the mirrors of the Viksit Bharat." The deliberations took place in two parallel sessions - the first focusing on Telangana Rising 2047 vision showcasing Hyderabad's urban priorities and the second session was on reviewing the progress of central schemes and interventions across the participating States/UTs. The Hon'ble Minister reviewed the progress of various central missions.

Under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana - Urban, the progress of housing construction under various verticals was discussed in addition to the issue of unoccupied houses and opening of SNA SPARSH accounts for expediting scheme implementation & completion.

Make every city secure & inclusive: Hon'ble MoS on World Habitat Day



The Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA) observed World Habitat Day on 8th October 2025 at Vigyan Bhawan in New Delhi on the theme 'Urban Solutions to Crisis'. The theme focused on how cities can better prepare for becoming resilient, inclusive and sustainable and also respond to challenges, including climate change, migration and urbanisation.

The guest of honour for the event was Hon'ble Minister of State (MoS) for Housing and Urban Affairs, Shri Tokhan Sahu. Shri Srinivas Katikithala, Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA), Shri Satinder Pal Singh, Additional Secretary, MoHUA, Shri Kuldip Narayan, Joint Secretary and Mission Director (JS&MD), Housing for All, Mr. Shombi Sharp, United Nations Resident Coordinator, UN-INDIA, senior officials of MoHUA and CMDs of autonomous organisations also attended the event, marked by participation of UN agencies, HUDCO, NHB among others.

Delivering the keynote address, Hon'ble MoS highlighted about sustainable urbanisation and how it is linked to a country's journey towards development. He said that efforts should be made to make every city dignified and opportunity-worthy for people. Hon'ble MoS further added that the theme of World Habitat Day 2025 is not just another calendar year, but a reminder to reaffirm India's commitment to building cities that are resilient, inclusive, sustainable, and also, cities that are prepared to face crisis and emerge stronger. He categorically added to work towards making cities secure, resilient, inclusive and future ready.

The Hon'ble MoS said, "If we invest wisely in resilience, empower local governments and harness the potential of Public-Private-People Partnerships, our cities will not only be able to withstand crisis but also emerge as powerful engines of growth."

In his address to the gathering, Secretary, MoHUA said that the policy response to urban crisis should focus on strengthening cities by making their infrastructure, social systems and economies more resilient and adaptable. He expressed that though there are wide array of challenges facing the cities, they also offer unique opportunities for transformative action, creating a positive cycle of growth and resilience. "India's approach is guided by a clear vision to turn these challenges into a foundation for future growth and prosperity," Secretary, MoHUA added.

Referring to the various flagship schemes of Ministry like PMAY-Urban, AMRUT, PM SVANidhi and Swachh Bharat Mission, Secretary, MoHUA further said that these schemes have been conceptualised with focus on vulnerable and marginalised sections and, together represent an integrated and multi-pronged strategy designed to achieve infrastructure development with social inclusion, climate action with economic empowerment.

The event was also marked by release of publications of organisations under MoHUA, which included Housing for All (HFA) Division, HUDCO, NCHF, NHB, CGEWHO, and BMTPC. The HFA division released a 'Compendium of Good Practices' which encapsulates the best practices undertaken by States/UTs in the successful implementation of PMAY-U.

Apart from the release of publications, prize distribution ceremony for winners of painting competitions organised by NHB, CGEWHO, HUDCO and BMTPC for school children, including specially-abled children, in various competitions was organised to commemorate the event.

In line with the vision of 'Viksit Bharat 2047', different panel discussions were held on topics such as 'Integration of Urban and Peri-urban Areas into Metropolitan Cities', 'Understanding and Responding to Urban Flooding' and 'Equitable Cities'. The discussions brought together policymakers, practitioners, researchers, subject matter experts, officials from States/UTs and research organisations who shared their insights on the subjects to make cities inclusive, liveable, equitable, sustainable, focussing that no citizen is left behind.



Secretary, MoHUA chairs 5th meeting of Central Sanctioning and Monitoring Committee, 10 lakh houses sanctioned under PMAY-U 2.0



The Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA) sanctioned 1.41 lakh additional houses under PMAY-U 2.0. The decision was taken during the 5th meeting of the Central Sanctioning and Monitoring Committee (CSMC), chaired by Shri Srinivas Katikithala, Secretary, MoHUA on 15th October 2025 in New Delhi. With the latest approvals of 1,40,942 houses, the total number of sanctions under the PMAY-U 2.0 scheme is over 10 lakh.

The meeting was attended by Shri Kuldip Narayan, Joint Secretary & Mission Director (JS&MD), HFA, MoHUA, Principal Secretaries from States/Union Territories (UTs), PMAY-U Mission Directors from different States/UTs and senior officials of the Ministry.

Secretary, MoHUA encouraged States/UTs to increase occupancy of houses while also ensuring infrastructure and connectivity in place. "After completion of houses under the scheme, ensure that there is accelerated occupancy. Projects should be finalised in places where there are adequate infrastructure, roads, public transportation and connectivity to ensure ease of living for beneficiaries," Secretary, MoHUA said.

JS&MD, HFA apprised Secretary, MoHUA about the status of implementation of PMAY-U 2.0 and said that States/UTs should focus on grounding and fast-tracking completion of houses. He added, "To support the financial needs of the beneficiaries, easy access to loan or loan melas should be organised which will help the beneficiaries to complete their houses on time. Further, the States/UTs should encourage beneficiaries to complete their houses on time and address the bottlenecks which is delaying the construction process."

The Committee also reviewed the progress of PMAY-U 2.0 and discussed the strategies to enhance the implementation of the scheme while ensuring timely completion of houses.

In the meeting, about 76,976 houses have been sanctioned for women alone, including single women, widows and females who are separated, underscoring the Government's resolve to empower women with access to a safe and dignified living. Additionally, for the welfare of the Senior Citizens, 13,509 houses have been sanctioned. Furthermore, catering to the housing needs of Transgenders, 7 houses have been allotted to them. Among the different underprivileged groups, 29,131 houses have been sanctioned for SC beneficiaries, 6,561 houses for ST beneficiaries and 74,291 for the OBC.

Meanwhile, in the total 10 lakh+ houses sanctioned under PMAY-U 2.0, more than 6.31 lakh houses have been allotted to women beneficiaries only, amongst which 70,794 beneficiaries are either widows, females who are separated or unmarried. PMAY-U 2.0 has also sanctioned 163 dwelling units to Transgenders. Additionally, 1.04 lakh houses have been allotted to senior citizens. While 2.20 lakh houses have been sanctioned for SC beneficiaries, 51,181 are ST beneficiaries whereas, 5.35 lakh are OBC beneficiaries.

Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana – Urban was launched in 2015 to provide all-weather pucca houses with basic amenities to eligible beneficiaries of urban India. Under PMAY-U, 95.51 lakh pucca houses have already completed and delivered to beneficiaries. Owing to the increase in affordable housing demand, the scheme was revamped and launched as PMAY-U 2.0 in September 2024 to provide financial support to additional 1 crore poor and middle-class families to construct or purchase a pucca house. Under PMAY-U and PMAY-U 2.0, the total number of houses sanctioned are 122 lakh.

JS&MD, HFA attends Urban Infrastructure Finance Festival in New Delhi

Shri Kuldip Narayan, JS&MD, HFA participated in the Urban Infrastructure Finance Festival held in New Delhi on 29th October 2025 on the broad theme of Inclusive, Resilient, Sustainable Cities. He chaired the panel discussion on "Building the Backbone: Investing in Affordable Housing as Infrastructure for Climate-Ready Cities".



During the discussion, JS&MD, HFA emphasised on the importance of need for growth of cities around planned urban settlements with robust social infrastructure & connectivity as it will prevent proliferation of slums, address tenure insecurity in informal settlements & enable access to finance for building homes. He further highlighted the need to develop simple, measurable tools for green rating and certification of housing projects to finance & incentivise housing initiatives.

Shri Narayan also urged the panellists to deliberate on ways to make housing, social infrastructure available to migrating population in the cities which are aspiring to be climate resilient.

The Urban Infrastructure Finance Festival brought together policymakers, financial experts and urban planners on one platform to devise strategies that ensure the successful implementation of crucial infrastructure projects. The 2-day event served as a critical step towards securing the future of urban India by enabling cities to highlight their investment-ready projects and build partnerships to attract the necessary capital to bring these visions to life.

JS&MD, HFA reviews progress of AHP project in Sri Vijaya Puram, A&N Islands



Shri Kuldip Narayan, JS&MD, Housing for All, recently visited an Affordable Housing in Partnership (AHP) project site constructed under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana – Urban in Sri Vijaya Puram, Andaman and Nicobar Islands.

The project comprises a total of 329 housing units, out of which 213 units are in advanced stage of completion & will soon be homes for more than 200 families.

During the visit, JS&MD, HFA interacted with project officials & reviewed the progress of construction work & emphasized on timely completion of the housing units to ensure the benefits of the scheme reach the eligible families at the earliest.





Message by JS&MD, HFA

PMAY-Urban is nearing its completion period. What began as a first-of-its-kind affordable housing initiative, soon evolved as one of the largest housing programmes of the world. The scheme has transformed the lives of crores of families of urban India. By providing dignified and secure pucca houses, PMAY-U has not only ensured improved living standards but also instilled a sense of ownership and belongingness among beneficiaries.

The scheme will culminate in December 2025, but parallelly, the 2.0 version of PMAY-U is being implemented with the target to provide pucca houses to 1 crore urban families. PMAY-U 2.0 was launched in September 2024 across the country, and I am happy to share that over 10 lakh houses have already been sanctioned. Under the scheme, financial assistance is being provided to beneficiaries to either construct or purchase a pucca house. Meanwhile PMAY-U 2.0 also provides special emphasis on promoting rental housing. Affordable Rental Housing has been added as a separate vertical to broaden the scheme's outreach and address the rental housing needs of migrant workers, working women, urban poor and other urban residents.

With PMAY-U 2.0, the Government has set the context straight that no eligible citizen will be left behind in getting access to a pucca house with all basic amenities. The scheme reinforces the commitment to ensure that every family, irrespective of income, gender or social background, has the opportunity to secure a safe and dignified home.

Angikaar 2025: Leaving No Citizen Behind


