The website is user friendly and contains all relevant and important documents such as Concept Note, Operational Guidelines, FAQs etc that will help the stakeholders to make informed decision.





Shri Durga Shanker Mishra, Secretary, MoHUA presided over the proceedings of the event and shared his pleasure to announce that website is user-friendly and informative for the stakeholders across India. He also said that Affordable Rental Housing Complexes (ARHCs) will provide social security and improve quality life of migrants, industrial labour, urban poor, and students etc.

Hon'ble Minister also released the National Report on ANGIKAAR which contains all activities that were under taken through the year 2019 - to educate PMAY(U) beneficiaries, create awareness and encourage them to actively participate in all events. The campaign was launched to facilaite social behaviour change, through awareness on best practices like water & energy conservation, waste management, health, tree plantation, sanitation and hygiene for beneficiaries under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana - Urban.

Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana - Urban (PMAY-U) does not only provide pucca houses to eligible beneficiaries of urban India but also brings with it a bouquet of essentials for a dignified living.

ANGIKAAR - a campaign for change management for beneficiaries launched in August 2019 has reaped tremendous results. The campaign was implemented through a 3 Cs strategy - Convergence, Community Engagement and Communication. It touched lives of more than 20 lakh households that availed benefits of various schemes and adopted best practices of health, hygiene, cleanliness, waste management, environment water, and energy conservation. Our objective of 'Housing for All' by 2022 also entails addressing issues that arise from life transformation when beneficiaries move into a pucca house. Shri Hardeep Singh Puri, Hon'ble Minister of State (I/C), Housing and Urban Affairs released a National Report on ANGIKAAR - on 14 October 2020. The report is a recollection of various activities under the campaign. Around 18500 ANGIKAAR Resource Persons were trained by about 2200 specialists of City Level Technical Cell (CLTC) working in 4430 cities of PMAY (U). The campaign has built capacities to manage change and also address issues that arose due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Now, ANGIKAAR 2020 version has set in with the theme of 'Healthy, Wealthy and Wise'. Initiatives like Fit India Freedom Run, Eat Right India movement, Financial Awareness Messages (FAME), PMAY (U) Awas Quiz, etc. have been taken up as part of ongoing efforts.

In addition, there is encouraging progress on the front of Affordable Rental Housing Complexes (ARHCs), a sub-scheme initiated recently under PMAY (U). 25 States/UTs have signed MoAs and rest are in process. Model RFP has been shared with States/UTs for selection of Concessionaire. Eol has been uploaded on the newly launched ARHC website. A User Guide and Operational Guidelines in Hindi have also been shared with stakeholders for ease of participation.

At the PMAY (U) Mission, ours is a continuous and calibrated effort towards finding solutions to the emerging needs of urban housing sector.



New Delhi, Oct 14 (PT) Union minister Hardeep Singh Puri said Wednesday that the Centre is extending several incentives, including free floor area ratio, concessional project finance and free of cost trunk infrastructure facilities under the Affordable Rental

Addressing a webinar, Puri said this initiative has been taken up to provide "dignified and affordable" living spaces to varied groups of the urban poor and migrants, including industrial and construction workers, and those working with market associations.
