Sub: Release of Rs.1,36,80,000/- as 2nd instalment / part of 2nd instalment of Central Assistance including part of 1st instalment (under ST component) to the State Govt. of Tamil Nadu for 03 AHP projects approved by CSMC in its 51st meeting under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana - Urban (PMAY-U) - Mission for the financial year 2022-23.

Sir,

The undersigned is directed to convey the Sanction of the President of India to the release of **Rs.1,36,80,000/- (Rupees One Crore, Thirty Six Lakh and Eighty Thousand only)** to State Govt. of Tamil Nadu as 2nd instalment / part of 2nd installment of Central grant including part of 1st instalment (**Scheduled Tribe Component**) for various AHP projects approved in **51st meeting** of the Central Sanctioning and Monitoring Committee (CSMC) for Creation of Capital Assets under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana – Urban (PMAY-U) for FY 2022-23. Details of the projects / releases are as under:

2. Based on the decision and recommendations of CSMC under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (PMAY) (Urban) in its **51st meeting** and compliances achieved by State Govt. in respect of aforesaid projects, the amount of central grant is being released subject to the following conditions:

- i. Necessary sanctions/ approvals/ compliances required under the statutory or other regulatory regime as applicable would be obtained by the authority (ies) concerned with the project (s).



- ii. The State Government and implementing agencies shall put in place a monitoring system to ensure that the project (s) achieve scheduled milestone and envisaged outcomes including implementation of reforms and other conditionalities required under the scheme.
- iii. The State Govt./implementing agencies shall utilize the grant in accordance with the approved guidelines for the implementation of the Scheme of PMAY-U.
- iv. The State Government shall furnish the Utilization Certificates of the Grant released in the prescribed format as per GFR-2017 and as provided in the scheme guidelines. The funds shall be utilized for the purpose for which these are sanctioned otherwise these will have to be refunded along with interest as per provisions in GFR-2017.
- v. PMAY-U, being a Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS), the State Government should strictly follow the revised procedure of fund flow as per instructions issued by Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance, Government of India vide O.M. No. 1(13)PFMS/FCD/2020 dated 23rd March 2021. These instructions have been made effective from 1st July, 2021 which inter-alia provides that
 - a. **The State Govt. will transfer the central assistance to the designated Single Nodal Agency (SNA) within a period of 21 days of its receipt. Corresponding State share should be released as early as possible and not later than 40 days of release of the Central share. The Central share shall not be diverted to the Personal Deposit (PD) account or any other account by the State Government. State Government/SNA/IAs shall not transfer scheme-related funds to any other bank account, except for actual payments under the scheme.**
 - b. **Central Assistance along with state share are to be kept by the Nodal Agency in the Single Nodal Account (SNA) opened in a Scheduled Commercial Bank for the purpose and the same is mapped in PFMS. The nodal agency will allocate drawing limits to implementing agencies (IAs) having zero balance subsidiary accounts duly mapped in PFMS and linked to SNA account for drawal of funds on real time basis from the Single Nodal Account.**
 - c. **The nodal agency shall ensure that the interest earned from the funds released, should be mandatorily remitted to respective consolidated funds on pro rata basis in terms of rule 230(8) of GFR 2017.**
 - d. **SNAs and IAs will mandatorily use the DBT/EAT module of PFMS or integrate their systems with the PFMS to ensure that information on PFMS is updated by each IA at least once every day.**
 - e. **SNA will keep all the funds received in the Single Nodal Account only and shall not divert the same to Fixed Deposits/Flexi-Account/Multi-Option Deposit Account/Corporate Liquid Term Deposit (CLTD) Account etc.**
 - f. **Further releases under the scheme will be made only after transfer of entire Central Assistance released till date along with corresponding State share in the SNA account and utilization of 75% of earlier releases along with corresponding State share.**



- vi. The State should ensure that data entry in PMAY (U) – MIS portal is completed at the earliest. The Central Assistance is being released on the basis of work order and RERA registration entered in PMAY (U)-MIS. Remaining part of 1st instalment/Subsequent instalment will be released based on valid beneficiaries entered in PMAY (U)-MIS.
 - vii. The State Government shall submit an authenticated certificate from the bank showing complete details of disbursement of funds to each beneficiary before release of subsequent installment.
 - viii. The State Government shall ensure the geo-tagging of all houses approved under AHP component of PMAY-U and subsequent release by the State Government to the beneficiaries should be made in 3-4 instalments depending on the progress/stage of construction of the house.
 - ix. State Government shall ensure that the specifications of the houses conform to NBC/IS Standards and that requisite infrastructure will be provided by the State Government/ULB.
 - x. State Government shall submit the Action Taken Report (ATR) on the observations/recommendations of Third Party Quality Monitoring Agency (TPQMA) for quality monitoring purpose before release of subsequent instalment.
 - xi. State Government should ensure that there is no violation of Model Code of Conduct while releasing funds to implementing Agencies/ULBs/Beneficiaries.
3. Release of the Grant may kindly be made to the State Government immediately. The funds may thereafter be released to the implementing agencies without any delay failing which the amounts would be recovered from the State Government with interest for the period of default.
4. The amount is debitabale from the account of the Central Government in the books under the following Head of Account under Demand No. 60 of M/o Housing and Urban Affairs for the year 2022-23:

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internal audit by the Principal Accounts Office of the Ministry or Department, whenever the Institution or Organization is called upon to do so.

7. Requisite UCs for release of 2nd installment of Central Assistance have been received from the State of Tamil Nadu and are enclosed herewith.
