I am directed to convey the mother sanction of the Competent Authority to the release of **₹18,38,600/- (Rupees Eighteen Lakh Thirty Eight Thousand and Six Hundred only)** to State Govt. of Jharkhand as 1st installment of Central Assistance for Geo-tagging activities performed by the State under BLC component of Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana - Urban (PMAY-U) Mission under SLS 2960 - Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojna (64) through SNA SPARSH. 2. The above grant is subject to the following conditions:

- The State will comply with the terms and conditions stipulated in the guidelines, CSMC directions and instructions issued by this Ministry.
- The State will utilize the sanctioned grant for the purpose for which it is released.
- 2nd installment will be released on the basis of actual accepted geo-tagging points on Bhuwan portal for each project for which funds have been released. There are 5 stages available on Bhuwan portal for which beneficiaries can be geo-tagged including completion stage. Before release of 2nd installment, the completion stage of all beneficiaries in a project must be done.
- The State Government/Nodal Agency shall strictly monitor the progress of the geo-tagging activities at each level.
- The amount of Central Assistance approved will form a part of capacity building plan of the State under PMAY-U Mission.
- Transfer of funds to different entities, if any may be made through PFMS, as applicable and where there is an element of cash transfers to individuals, the same may be made through DBT/EAT module of PFMS mode, as applicable.

vii. Any unspent balance lying in State Treasury/SNA Accounts prior to on-boarding of the State Government on SNA SPARSH will be subject to guidelines issued by Department of Expenditure (DoE) from time to time

3. The expenditure involved is debit to the following Head of Account under Demand No. 60 of Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs for the year 2024-25:

The State Government is required to contribute approved matching State share under the scheme. State to ensure timely release of matching State share.


5. This being the first instalment of Central Assistance, no UC is required/due for above release.


