Sub: Issuance of Mother Sanction for release of ₹ 11,94,30,000/- to State Govt. of Nagaland on account of revalidation of lapsed amount of Mother Sanction of ₹ 11,94,30,000/- issued in FY 2025-26 vide sanction of even number dated 20.03.2026 through SNA SPARSH, for the Financial Year 2026-27 - reg.

Sir,


I am directed to issue the Mother sanction, with the approval of competent authority, to release ₹ 11,94,30,000/- (**Rupees Eleven Crore Ninety-Four Lakh and Thirty Thousand only**) to the State Govt. of Nagaland through SNA SPARSH as 1st installment of Central assistance for 8 BLC projects approved by CSMC in its 6th meeting, for BLC projects approved by CSMC in various meetings for creation of Capital Assets under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana - Urban 2.0 (PMAY-U 2.0) - Housing for All (Urban) Mission for the FY 2026-27 under **SLS NL 333-NL PMAY-U 2.0 BLC**.

2. The above release is on account of revalidation of lapsed amount of Mother sanction of ₹ 1194.30 lakh [OT-1194.30 lakh (including 1192.50 lakh as CA for ST beneficiaries released due to unavailability of sufficient fund under STC Head at the time)] issued in FY 2025-26 vide letter of even number dated 17.04.2025 through SNA SPARSH. Details of release are as under:

3. Based on the scheme guidelines, decisions & recommendations of CSMC under PMAY-U 2.0 and compliances achieved by State Govt. in respect of aforesaid projects, the amount of central grant is being released subject to the following conditions:

- Necessary sanctions/ approvals/ compliances required under the statutory or other regulatory regime as applicable would be obtained by the authority (ies) concerned with the project (s).
- The State Government and Implementing agencies shall put in place a monitoring system to ensure that the project (s) achieve scheduled milestone and envisaged outcomes including implementation of reforms and other conditionalities required under the scheme.

- iii. The State Govt./implementing agencies shall utilize the grant in accordance with the approved guidelines for the implementation of the Scheme of PMAY-U 2.0.
 - iv. Any unspent balance lying in the State Treasury, SNA Accounts prior to on-boarding of the State Government of SNA-SPARSH will required to be transferred immediately to Consolidated Fund of India (CFI)/ Consolidated Fund of State (CFS) as the case may be as per the guidelines issued by DoE for SNA SPARSH.
 - v. The State Government shall ensure the geo-tagging of all the houses approved under BLC component of PMAY-U 2.0 at different levels for release of subsequent installment of Central assistance.
 - vi. State Government shall ensure that the specifications of the houses conform to NBC/IS Standards and that requisite infrastructure will be provided by the State Government/ULB.
 - vii. The 2nd installment of Central assistance under BLC will be released after State will submit the Utilization Certificate of atleast 75% of fund released by Centre as well as State Government in a Financial Year and commensurate physical progress.
 - viii. The 2nd installment of 40% for BLC houses shall be released to "Lintel Stage" geo tagged houses from time to time.
 - ix. State Government shall ensure that all houses under BLC vertical should be completed within 12-18 months from the date of sanction by the CSMC.
 - x. State Government shall provide all basic civic amenities in the areas where BLC houses being constructed before completion of houses.
 - xi. State Government shall ensure using the Unified Web Portal (UWP) of PMAY-U 2.0 for all related activities of scheme such as applications by beneficiaries, verification of beneficiaries, Geo-tagging of beneficiaries, attachment of beneficiaries, preparation/creation of projects, generating beneficiaries list, generation of releases of various installments of Central assistance and its utilization amongst others as per the prescribed guidelines issued by this Ministry, rather than creating/developing their own MIS system.
 - xii. State Government should ensure that there is no violation of Model Code of Conduct while releasing funds to implementing Agencies/ULBs/Beneficiaries.
4. The amount is debitible from the account of the Central Government in the books under the respective Head of Accounts under Demand No. 60 of M/o Housing and Urban Affairs for the year 2026-27.
5. This admissible Central liability will be released to the Government of Nagaland on demand through SNA SPARSH only or/and as per the latest guidelines of Department of Expenditure. As the State has onboarded on SNA SPARSH, all the committed liabilities shall be released in SNA SPARSH only. The State Government is required to contribute approved matching State share under the scheme.

6. As per rule 236(1) of GFR, 2017, the relevant accounts of the Grantee Institution(s)/Organisation(s) shall be open to inspection by the sanctioning authority and audit, both by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provision of CAG (DPC) Act 1971 and internal audit by the Principal Accounts Office of the Ministry or Department, whenever the Institution or Organisation is called upon to do so.

7. This sanction issues with the concurrence of the Finance Division vide their **Note #10** in File No. N-11012/6/2026-HFA-III-MoHUA (Computer No. 9215126) **dated 10.04.2026**.
